Bring your unwanted appliances, old tires, household hazardous waste, dead batteries. We have made special arrangements to recycle these items to avoid unnecessary disposal at the landfill. Here are the details.

### BATTERIES-FREE RECYCLING

Bring household dry-cell batteries, including button cell type and auto lead-acid Batteries. We will recycle the batteries for their lead, mercury, nickel cadmium, zinc, etc.

### TIRES- FREE RECYCLING

Passenger and light truck tires only. Must be off the rim. \$2.00 fee if on the rim. No commercial dealers.

### PAINT-\$1.00 per gallon, \$.50 per quart or smaller, cash only

Latex and oil based paints only. No Commercial or industrial paints. Aerosol and household paint only. Paints must be in their original container for quick identification. Need paint? Pick some up here free.

### APPLIANCES-\$15.00 FEE, CASH ONLY, freon containing appliances.

#### **No charge for other appliances.**

Appliances accepted include; refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers, dehumidifiers, water coolers, washers, dryers, stoves, microwave ovens, trash compactors, water heaters, furnaces, humidifiers, dishwashers, garbage disposals, and automatic garage door mechanisms.

Chemicals, herbicides, cleaners, pesticides-this day only!
