IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT OF ALEXA ROHM TO THE POSITION OF PART-TIME OFFICE ASSISTANT POSITION FOR AUGLAIZE COUNTY.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 16th day of April, 2015.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Scott Cisco, Solid Waste Coordinator, recommended to the Board of County Commissioners the employment of a part-time Office Assistant position; and,

WHEREAS, the Board solicited resumes for the position, receiving fourteen (14) resumes; and,

WHEREAS, seven candidates were interviewed for the position by Solid Waste Coordinator, Scott Cisco and County Administrator, Erica Preston, and three candidates were interviewed again by the Board of County Commissioners; and,

WHEREAS, after the interviews Mr. Cisco recommended to the Board that the appointment for the part-time Office Assistant position be made to Alexa Rohm; and,

WHEREAS, Ms. Rohm was contacted about filling the Part-time Office Assistant position and she has accepted the position with the effective date of employment being April 20, 2015 with a starting wage of \$11.00 per hour and working approximately twenty (20) hours per week or on such alternating schedule as may be determined by the Board of County Commissioners with the input from Solid Waste Coordinator Scott Cisco and Ms. Rohm for a total of approximately 40 hours per bi-weekly pay period; there will be a 1,000 hour probationary period.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby authorize the employment of Alexa Rohm as a part-time Office Assistant position as mentioned above; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following stipulations apply to this employment:

1. Compensation for Ms. Rohm will be \$11.00 per hour.
2. There will be a probationary period of 1,000 hours, after probation is satisfactorily served, Ms. Rohm may receive up to a \$0.22 per hour increase in compensation, as determined by the Board of County Commissioners.
3. Ms. Rohm has agreed to and signed the position requirements.
4. Ms. Rohm will be required to work on an as needed basis.
5. Employment to commence on Monday, April 20, 2015.
6. Ms. Rohm will not receive health insurance, vacation days or holiday pay.
