**NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING**  
**FY2014 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)**  
**Community Development Allocation**

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners intends to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Community Development Program, a federal program administered by the State of Ohio. The first of two required public hearings was held March 3, 2014 to inform citizens about the CDBG program, eligible activities, and other requirements. The Board publicly solicited project proposals from the villages, cities, townships, and other eligible entities in the County. Proposed use of funds is set forth below.

The County is eligible to utilize \$97,000 in CDBG Community Development Allocation funds, providing program requirements are met. The program includes allocations for the former acquired cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta. Based on citizen input and local officials' assessment of needs, compliance with a CDBG National Objective, number of beneficiaries served, number of previous awards, and the reduced amount of CDBG funds awarded by ODSA to the County for the Allocation Program, the Board is proposing to use the funds as follows:

1) City of St. Marys Kuck's Kove Park Playground Structure Safety Padding (CDBG Funds/LMI National Objective)	\$29,000
2) City of Wapakoneta Gibbs Street Sidewalk Improvements-Phase 2 (CDBG Funds/LMI National Objective)	\$29,000
3) Village of Cridersville Tower Park Shelter House Replacement (CDBG Funds/LMI National Objective)	\$19,600
4) Administration (CDBG Funds)	\$15,400
5) Fair Housing (CDBG Funds)	<u>\$ 4,000</u>
Total	\$97,000

### **FY2014 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT & PRESERVATION (CHIP) PROGRAM**

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners intends to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) for funding of Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) Program activities under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program and the Federal HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME), both federally funded programs administered by the State of Ohio. The CHIP Applications are due to the State by June 6, 2014.

On March 3, 2014, Auglaize County conducted the first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other program requirements.

Auglaize County is proposing to undertake the following County-wide CHIP activities for FY2014: Private Owner Rehabilitation/Optional Temporary Relocation \$242,000 (HOME); Home Repair \$110,000 (CDBG); Fair Housing \$4,000 (CDBG); and Administration \$44,000 (\$22,000 CDBG and \$22,000 HOME). CHIP activities satisfy the LMI National Objective. The County is applying for a total of \$400,000 to fund these activities.
