**IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING THE PETITION AND BOND FOR THE HUEBNER DITCH PROJECT;
FIXING DATE OF VIEW AND HEARING FOR SAME.**

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 31st day of July, 2012.

Commissioner Regula moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on July 24, 2012, the County Engineer Doug Reinhart filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, a petition signed by Dennis Werling and others, as petitioners, to install subsurface tile, make lateral connections to existing drainage lines, install fittings and elbows, and place catch basins or manholes as required to satisfy the prayer of the petition; the substance and prayer of which said petition is, that the construction of the improvement is necessary and will be conducive to the public welfare, and prays for the making of such improvement on the following described course:

Commencing at a Point 2,650 feet south of Pusheta Road, approximately 550 feet west of the intersection with Townline Lima Road (North) and Pusheta Road (West) located in Section 13, Pusheta Township;

Thence South and Southeasterly following the course of an existing subsurface clay tile and through the Jurosic, Fisher, Elsass, Quietcove Farms, Bailey and Zink properties for approximately 5,900 feet to an existing drainage ditch that is currently under permanent maintenance of the Auglaize County Commissioners and there to terminate. The existing drainage ditch at the point of termination of this petition is known as Pusheta Ditch.

Said improvement is to be known as the Huebner Ditch.

The above described construction, engineering, and maintenance shall all be assessed to the benefitting parcels of ground as described in Section 6131 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The exact size(s) and location of said Storm Sewer shall be determined by the Auglaize County Engineer at the time of the Survey and Design of the proposed drainage petition.

WHEREAS, it appears to said Board that the proper bond has been filed with the petition, approved, conditioned for the payment of costs of notices, plus any other incidental expenses, except the cost made by the Engineer in making his survey, maps, plans, profiles and schedules, if the prayer of the petition is not granted, or if said petition is for any cause dismissed.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby accept the petition and bond for the Huebner Ditch Project; setting the 13th day of September, 2012, at 1:00 p.m., local time, meeting on Townline Lima Rd, 1/4 mile north of Freyburg East Road, as the time and place for the view thereon; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the 18th day of October, 2012, at 10:00 a.m., local time, in the Commissioners Chambers, Auglaize Acres – 2nd Floor, 13093 Infirmarary Road, Wapakoneta, Ohio, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the first hearing on the petition; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of said view and hearing be given as requested by law.

Proceedings to: To install subsurface tile, make lateral connections to existing drainage lines, install fittings and elbows, and place catch basins or manholes as required to satisfy the prayer of the petition. Once the project has been completed, the landowners shall have the drainage petition placed on Permanent Maintenance as per Section 6131 and 6133 of the Ohio Revised Code.
