

**AUGLAIZE COUNTY EMERGENCY OPERATIONS PLAN  
PROMULGATION STATEMENT – RESOLUTION**

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**WHEREAS** the primary role of a government is to provide for the general welfare of its citizens. Preparedness to cope with the effects of a disaster includes many diverse but interrelated elements which must be woven into an integrated emergency management system involving all departments of local government and private support agencies, as well as the individual citizen.

**AND WHEREAS** planning for population protection must be a cooperative effort to avert or minimize the effects of natural, technological, and/or man-made disasters, protect lives and property, and restore the stricken area to its pre-disaster status with a minimum of social and economic disruption.

**SO AS A RESULT**, pursuant to the State Emergency Services Act (Ohio Revised Code, Sections 5502.22 and 3760, as amended) Auglaize County has established the Auglaize County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management Agency (EMA), and that the EMA is, to the limits of its capabilities, responsible for the disaster preparedness activities within Auglaize County.

**AND WHEREAS** the *Auglaize County Emergency Operations Plan* was developed to be responsive to federal requirements contained in the National Incident Management System (NIMS) and is subject to approval by the State of Ohio and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA).



**IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING THE PETITION AND BOND FOR THE DOENGES #2 DITCH PROJECT;  
FIXING DATE OF VIEW AND HEARING FOR SAME.**

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The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 16th day of October, 2014.

Commissioner Regula moved the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, on October 9, 2014, the County Engineer Doug Reinhart filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, a petition signed by Kenneth Sudman and Harold Dammeyer, as petitioners, to install subsurface tile, make lateral connections to existing drainage lines, install fittings and elbows, and place catch basins or manholes as required to satisfy the prayer of the petition, which said petition is, that the construction of the improvement is necessary and will be conducive to the public welfare, and prays for the making of such improvement on the following described course:

Commencing at a bridge over State Route 364 located approximately 2,200 feet south of State Route 219 in Section 30, St. Marys Township, Auglaize County; thence westerly in direction with an open ditch through the James and Patricia Sealscott property for approximately 500 feet; thence continuing westerly in direction with a 24" diameter subsurface tile through the Kenneth and Regina Sudman property for approximately 850 feet; thence continuing with a 24" diameter subsurface tile in a westerly and southerly direction through the Harold Dammeyer property for approximately 700 feet; thence continuing with a 24" diameter subsurface tile in a southerly direction into the Erik and Janna Hirschfeld property for approximately 500 feet and there to terminate.

Said improvement is to be known as the Doenges #2 Ditch.

The above described construction, engineering, and maintenance shall all be assessed to the benefitting parcels of ground as described in Section 6131 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The exact size(s) and location of said Storm Sewer shall be determined by the Auglaize County Engineer at the time of the Survey and Design of the proposed drainage petition. All costs of the engineering, construction and maintenance shall be assessed to the benefitting parcels of ground as outlined in Section 6131 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**WHEREAS**, it appears to said Board that the proper bond has been filed with the petition, approved, conditioned for the payment of costs of notices, plus any other incidental expenses, except the cost made by the Engineer in making his survey, maps, plans, profiles and schedules, if the prayer of the petition is not granted, or if said petition is for any cause dismissed.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby accept the petition and bond for the Doenges #2 Ditch Project; setting the 25th day of November, 2014, at 10:00 a.m., local time, meeting on State Route 364, 1/2 south of State Route 219, as the time and place for the view thereon; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the 18th day of December, 2014, at 10:00 a.m. local time, in the Assembly Room – 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, Administration Building, Wapakoneta, Ohio, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the first hearing on the petition; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that notice of said view and hearing be given as requested by law.
