**IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING THE PETITION AND BOND FOR THE WHEELER DITCH PROJECT;  
FIXING DATE OF VIEW AND HEARING FOR SAME.**

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The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October, 2012.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, on October 23, 2012, the County Engineer Doug Reinhart filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, a petition signed by Gerald Wheeler, as petitioner, to install subsurface tile, make lateral connections to existing drainage lines, install fittings and elbows and place catch basins or manholes as required to satisfy the prayer of the petition; the substance and prayer of which said petition is, that the construction of the improvement is necessary and will be conducive to the public welfare, and prays for the making of such improvement on the following described course:

Commencing at a point on the north side of Edgewater Drive, approximately 80 feet west of the intersection of Shaborn Drive, Section 6, Saint Marys Township;

Thence North and Northwesterly following the course of an existing subsurface clay tile and through the Nazarne Center property for approximately 1,850 feet to an existing subsurface tile under State Route 703.

Said improvement is to be known as the Wheeler Ditch.

The above described construction, engineering, and maintenance shall all be assessed to the benefitting parcels of ground as described in Section 6131 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The exact size(s) and location of said Storm Sewer shall be determined by the Auglaize County Engineer at the time of the Survey and Design of the proposed drainage petition.

**WHEREAS**, it appears to said Board that the proper bond has been filed with the petition, approved, conditioned for the payment of costs of notices, plus any other incidental expenses, except the cost made by the Engineer in making his survey, maps, plans, profiles and schedules, if the prayer of the petition is not granted, or if said petition is for any cause dismissed.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby accept the petition and bond for the Wheeler Ditch Project; setting the 8th day of January, 2013, at 1:00 p.m., local time, meeting on Edgewater Drive, 325' west of Koenig Road, as the time and place for the view thereon; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the 12th day of February, 2013, at 10:00 a.m., local time, in the Commissioners Chambers, Administration Building – Assembly Room, 209 S. Blackhoof Street, Wapakoneta, Ohio, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the first hearing on the petition; and,

**WHEREAS**, petition document reads:

“ Whereas the road located in Section 22 Noble Township connecting Delphos-Saint Marys Road (CR 66A) and Saint Marys River Road (CR 41A) does not presently have a name only a number (CR 168); and where the Ohio Revised Code requires all roads to have a name and number, and since there was a mill located along river on the south side of the road, known as Broadwell Mill that operated from the spring of 1835 until the end of the 19<sup>th</sup> century, therefore we the following petitioners are requesting that the said road be hereafter be known as the Old Mill Road.”; and,

**WHEREAS**, Engineer Reinhart supports this petition and to establish the road name, informing the Board that in the 1970's the Auglaize County Highway Department constructed a new bridge over the St. Marys River and connector road, 650' in length, between County Road #66A and the St. Marys River Road in Section 22, St. Marys Township. This particular section of roadway was designated County Road #168, but never named; and,
