



## AUGLAIZE COUNTY RECYCLING MATERIALS LIST



Glass - Bottles and Jars in Clear, Brown, and Green colors. General rule is that at one time the container had a cap or lid. We can recycle only container glass, no ceramics, cooking glass, window glass or auto glass.

Cans – Aluminum cans, tin and steel food cans. Please separate aluminum from other cans. Aerosol cans that are empty are also acceptable. Aluminum foil and pie pans are acceptable.

Cardboard – Corrugated cardboard. Please breakdown boxes to use less space in transportation to processing center. Cereal type boxes should be placed with mixed paper.

Plastic – We can recycle the below types of plastic containers. Please check the bottom of the container for the number in the recycling symbol

- # 1 PETE – This is the pop and water type containers.
- # 2 HDPE – Color – This is the soap and detergent type containers of any color.
- # 2 Natural – This is the frosty type containers such as some milk and juice containers.

Mixed Paper - This is the newspaper, slick ads, phone books, office paper, paper board (Cereal type boxes), magazines, and envelopes.

- Electronics – Any type of computer equipment.
  - CD players
  - Cell Phones
  - All equipment
    - Televisions are a \$5.00 charge if 27” or smaller

Motor Oil – Please bring in with containers of five gallon size or smaller. This allows for the personnel to handle the product easier.

Shoes – Any shoes paired together. No rubber type rain boots or shoes with heels over two inches.

Holiday Lights - Any old light strings, can have bulbs in them.

Batteries - Any type of dry cell or wet cell batteries.

Cartons are also accepted.

Any other special items, call the Solid Waste District Office at 419-394-1270 and we will try to assist you in finding a place for the item to be recycled if possible.
