

IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING THE HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS MATERIALS AND TIRE COLLECTION POLICY AND SETTING THE FEES FOR SAID COLLECTION AND AUTHORIZING THE SOLID WASTE DISTRICT COORDINATOR TO ESTABLISH A PETTY CASH POLICY FOR THE AUGLAIZE COUNTY SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 21st day of July, 2015.

Commissioner Regula moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Scott Cisco, Solid Waste District Coordinator, submitted correspondence stating that the Solid Waste facility historically held a Household Hazardous Day to dispose of several materials including but not limited to household batteries, paint, chemicals, herbicides, cleaners, pesticides, and tire and Mr. Cisco believes the cost of this event is excessive and does not currently meet the needs of the whole county; and,

WHEREAS, the Solid Waste District Coordinator is proposing to implement a new policy effective August 1, 2015 for disposing of the household hazardous material and tire collection and setting fees as follows:

- 1) During the months of May through October annually materials may be dropped off on the 2nd Wednesday of each month between the hours of 8:30 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.
- 2) All materials must be taken to the St. Marys Recycling Center located at 15502 Saint Marys River Road, St. Marys, Ohio 45885;
- 3) Will accept household batteries and non-freon appliances at no charge;
- 4) Will accept paint with a charge for the following:
 - a. \$1.00 fee for each container up to 1 gallon
 - b. Each additional gallon is an additional \$1.00 fee
- 5) Will accept chemicals, herbicides, cleaners, and pesticides with a fee of \$1.00 per pound for these materials;
- 6) Will accept tires – off the rim – with a fee for the following:
 - a. Passenger and light truck truck - \$3.00 fee,
 - b. Large Truck and Agricultural Tires - \$5.00 fee,
 - c. Semi-Truck Tires, Tractor Fronts Tires (3 rib or 4 rib) - \$8.00 fee,
 - d. Tractor Tires (Lug Type) - \$22.00 fee;
- 7) Will accept Freon containing appliances with a \$25.00 fee; and,

WHEREAS the Solid Waste District Coordinator shall review the fee schedule based on market conditions and make any recommended changes to the Auglaize County Board of Solid Waste Directors for final approval; and,

WHEREAS, to support the household hazardous material and tire collection policy implementation, the St. Marys Recycling will need to establish a petty cash fund policy to maintain accurate material records and financial responsibility.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio and the Board of Directors for the Auglaize County Solid Waste Management District, does hereby approve the Household Hazardous Material and Tire Collection Policy and above mentioned fees to be effective August 1, 2015; and,

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners Auglaize County, Ohio and the Board of Directors for the Auglaize County Solid Waste Management District, does hereby authorize the Solid Waste District Coordinator to establish a petty cash policy in accordance with all applicable laws in order to accommodate for the new household hazardous collection plan.
