

**IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING A RESOLUTION FOR THE PARTICIPATION IN THE ODOT ANNUAL CONTRACT FOR ROAD SALT.**

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The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 12th day of April, 2022.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the County Engineer, Auglaize County, 1014 South Blackhoof Street, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895 (hereinafter referred to as the "Political Subdivision") hereby submits this written agreement to participate in the Ohio Department of Transportation's (ODOT) annual road salt bid in accordance with Ohio Revised Code 5513.01(B) and hereby agrees to all of the following terms and conditions in its participation of the ODOT road salt contract:

- a. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to be bound by all terms and conditions established by ODOT in the road salt contract and acknowledges that upon award of the contract by the Director of ODOT it shall be bound by all such terms and conditions included in the contract; and
- b. The Political Subdivision hereby acknowledges that upon the Director of ODOT's signing of the road salt contract, it shall effectively form a contract between the awarded salt supplier and the Political Subdivision; and
- c. The Political Subdivision agrees to be solely responsible for resolving all claims or disputes arising out of its participation in the ODOT road salt contract and agrees to hold the Department of Transportation harmless for any claims, actions, expenses, or other damages arising out of the Political Subdivision's participation in the road salt contract; and
- d. The Political Subdivision's electronic order for Sodium Chloride (Road Salt) will be the amount the Political Subdivision agrees to purchase from its awarded salt supplier at the delivered bid price per ton awarded by the Director of ODOT; and
- e. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to purchase a minimum of 90% of its above-requested salt quantities from its awarded salt supplier during the contract's effective period; and
- f. The Political Subdivision hereby agrees to place orders with and directly pay the awarded salt supplier on a net 30 basis for all road salt it receives pursuant to ODOT salt contract; and
- g. The Political Subdivision acknowledges that should it wish to rescind this participation agreement it will do so by written, emailed request by no later than Friday, April 30, 2022 by 12:00 p.m. The written, emailed request to rescind this participation agreement must be received by the ODOT Office of Contract Sales, Purchasing Section email: [Contracts.Purchasing@dot.ohio.gov](mailto:Contracts.Purchasing@dot.ohio.gov) by the deadline. The Department, upon receipt, will respond that it has received the request and that it has effectively removed the Political Subdivision's participation request. Furthermore, it is the sole responsibility of the Political Subdivision to ensure ODOT has received this participation agreement as well as the receipt of any request to rescind this participation agreement. The Department shall not be held responsible or liable for failure to receive a Political Subdivision's participation agreement and/or a Political Subdivision's request to rescind its participation agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the following authorized person(s) that this participation agreement for the ODOT winter road salt contract is hereby approved, funding has been authorized, and the Political Subdivision agrees to the above terms and conditions regarding participation on the ODOT winter salt contract.

**IN THE MATTER OF FIXING DATE AND TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE HEIDT DITCH AND TO REEVALUATE THE MAINTENANCE BASE ON SAID DITCH PROJECT.**

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The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 12th day of April, 2022.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, Drainage Technician TJ Place presented the following correspondence to the Board on March 31, 2022:

In 1960, the Heidt Ditch was petitioned through Auglaize County Engineer's Office, reconstructed and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Highway Department. This 5,400 feet long improvement drains a watershed of 1,021 acres and in 1960, cost \$6,619.77 for the reconstruction of the open ditch. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 62 years of our department maintaining this project and using the 1960 construction cost as the base amount, this amount is no longer sufficient enough to keep the account stable due to inflation.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$53,183.67. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 5,400 feet of the Heidt Ditch as done in 1960 for \$6,619.77. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 62 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this open ditch such as herbicide spraying, periodic bottom dip-outs and erosion control.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the Heidt watershed and we are asking the Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a maintenance hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code. This department will prepare and mail the notices to the property owners within the watershed.

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The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 12th day of April, 2022.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

**WHEREAS**, Drainage Technician TJ Place presented the following correspondence to the Board on March 31, 2022:

In 1983, the Herbst Ditch was petitioned through Auglaize County Soil and Water Conservation, reconstructed and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Highway Department. This 9,233 feet long improvement drains a watershed of 363 acres and in 1983, cost \$2,338.80 for the reconstruction of the open ditch. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 39 years of our department maintaining this project and using the 1983 construction cost as the base amount, this amount is no longer sufficient enough to keep the account stable due to inflation.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$11,357.00. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 9,233 feet of the Herbst Ditch as done in 1983 for \$2,338.80. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 39 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this open ditch such as herbicide spraying, periodic bottom dip-outs and erosion control.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the Herbst watershed and we are asking the Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a maintenance hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code. This department will prepare and mail the notices to the property owners within the watershed.

**WHEREAS,** Drainage Technician TJ Place presented the following correspondence to the Board on March 31, 2022:

In 1976, the Doering Ditch was petitioned through Auglaize County Engineer's Office, reconstructed and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Highway Department. This 2,170 feet long improvement drains a watershed of 394 acres and in 1976, cost \$2,967.00 for the reconstruction of the open ditch. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 46 years of our department maintaining this project and using the 1976 construction cost as the base amount, this amount is no longer sufficient enough to keep the account stable due to inflation.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$16,528.13. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 2,170 feet of the Doering Ditch as done in 1976 for \$2,967.00. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 46 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this open ditch such as herbicide spraying, periodic bottom dip-outs and erosion control.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the Doering watershed and we are asking the Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a maintenance hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code. This department will prepare and mail the notices to the property owners within the watershed.

**WHEREAS**, Drainage Technician TJ Place presented the following correspondence to the Board on March 31, 2022:

In 1987, the Moorman Ditch was petitioned through Auglaize County Engineer's Office, reconstructed and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Highway Department. This 4,112 feet of tile drains a watershed of 71 acres and in 1987, cost \$12,294.82 for the installation of the drainage tiles. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 35 years of our department maintaining this project and using the 1987 construction cost as the base amount, this amount is no longer sufficient enough to keep the account stable due to inflation.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$59,745.20. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 4,112 feet of the Moorman Ditch as done in 1987 for \$12,294.82. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 35 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this tile ditch such as tile blowouts or replacement and erosion control.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the Moorman watershed and we are asking the Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a maintenance hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code. This department will prepare and mail the notices to the property owners within the watershed.

In general, the project consists of installing wall curb, storm drainage and rubber safety padding around play structures in the City of St. Marys.
