### Village of Buckland Main Street Curb and Sidewalk Improvements

Sealed Bids for the Village of Buckland Main Street Curb and Sidewalk Improvements will be received by the Auglaize County Commissioners at Auglaize Acres Building, Commissioners Chambers, Second Floor, 13093 Infirmery Road, Wapakoneta, OH 45895, until Tuesday, May 8, 2012, at 2:00pm, at which time they will be publicly opened and read.

In general, the Work consists of improvements to Main Street in the Village of Buckland including curb and gutter, asphalt, and catch basin replacement on the west side of the street. The project is funded by the federal CDBG Community Development Program. The Engineer's Estimate is \$208,485.00.

The Bidding Documents which include drawings and specifications may be examined and obtained at the office of Choice One Engineering Corporation, 440 East Hoewisher Road, Sidney, OH 45365. Cost for the Bidding Documents is \$60.00 and is non-refundable (checks made payable to "Choice One Engineering").

Bids must be signed and submitted on the separate bidding forms included in the Bidding Documents, sealed in a properly identified envelope, and shall be accompanied by either a Bid Guaranty Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid amount or by a certified check, cashier's check, or letter of credit on a solvent bank in the amount of not less than 10% of the amount of the Bid, subject to conditions provided in the Instructions to Bidders. The successful BIDDER will be required to furnish a satisfactory Performance Bond in the amount of 100% of the Bid.

The Contractor shall be required to pay not less than the minimum wage rates established by the Federal Labor Standards Provisions and Davis-Bacon Wages. Attention of the BIDDER is called to the various insurance requirements and various equal opportunity provisions.

No BIDDER shall withdraw his Bid within 60 days after the actual opening thereof.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all Bids, waive irregularities in any Bid, and to accept any Bid which is deemed by Owner to be most favorable to the Owner.
