



The construction of the improvement is necessary, and will be conducive to the public welfare. The following is the course and termini of said improvement, to wit:

Commencing at the terminus of the existing Craft Ditch located approximately 1,100 feet west of Maier Barber Road and approximately 3,200 feet North of Arnold Road; thence extending the maintenance approximately 450 feet north to the property line of Parcel H23-007-008-00 owned by David and Lyndelle Craft. The above described open ditch being located in the Southeast Quarter of Section 7, Noble Township, Town-4, Range-5, Auglaize County, Ohio.

The above described open ditch has been evaluated by the Auglaize County Engineers office and meets the qualifications to be placed under the permanent maintenance program.

All cost of engineering, construction and future maintenance shall be assessed to the benefiting parcels of ground. Exact sizes, depth and location will be determined at the time of the engineering study between the first and second hearings.

A list of names and addresses, where known, of all landowners which the Petitioner claims will be benefitted or damaged by the construction of the proposed improvement is attached.

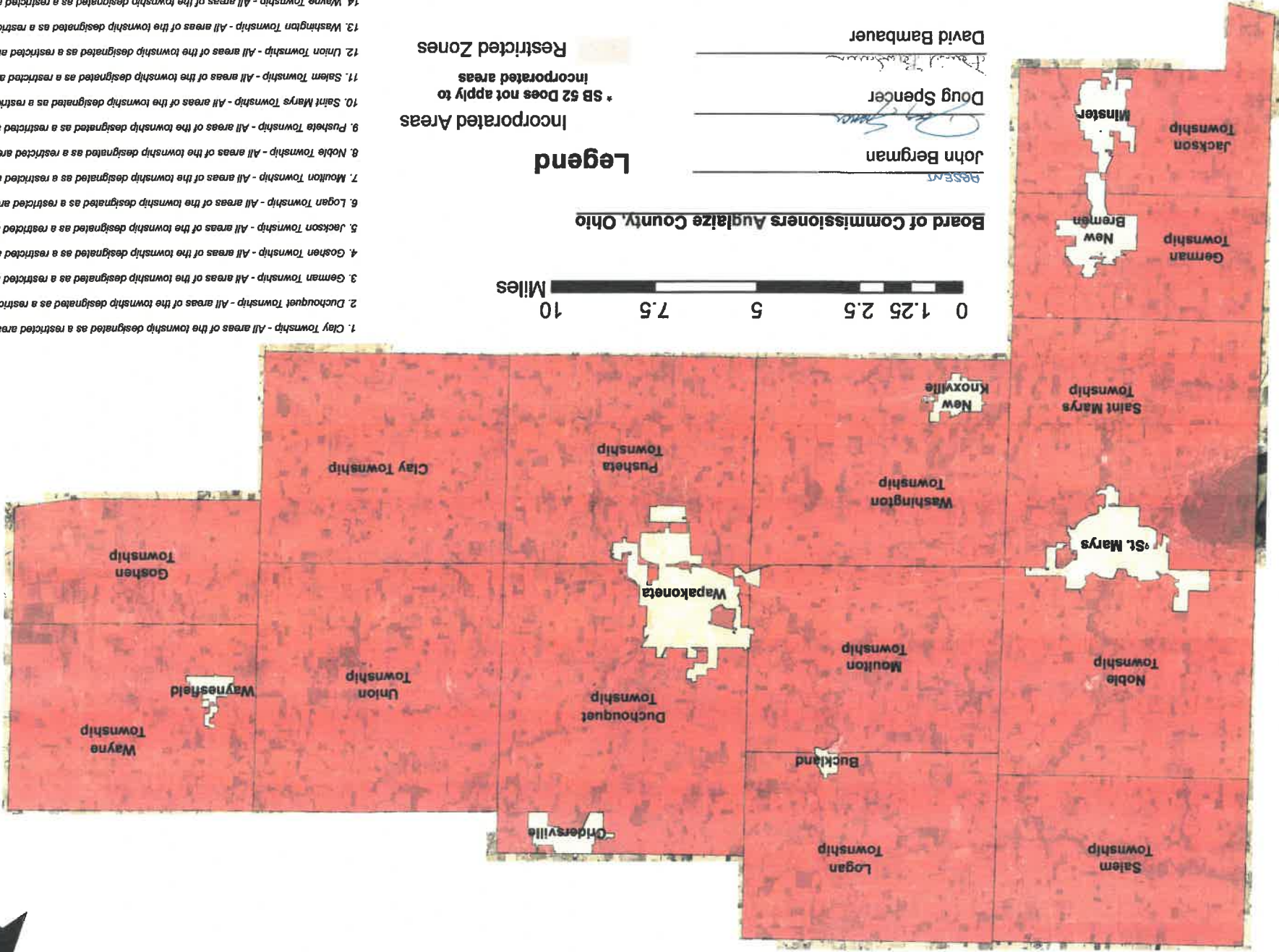
