IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING THE RE-EVALUATION OF THE ASSESSMENT BASE FOR THE MAINTENANCE FOR THE SIX MILE DITCH; CHANGING THE WATERSHED MAP AND CERTIFYING THE MAINTENANCE BASE AND AUTHORIZES A 5% COLLECTION FEE TO BE COLECTED FOR THE FOLLOWING YEARS, 2024, 2025 AND 2026 TO THE COUNTY AUDITOR.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 27th day of April, 2023.

Commissioner Spaces moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS, in Resolution #23-137, the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners set this date, April 27, 2023, to hold a public hearing on the base assessments for the Six Mile Ditch Maintenance fund established in 1960; and,
- WHEREAS, that this hearing is for the review and re-evaluation of the Six Mile Ditch which is provided under section 6137.112 of the Ohio Revised Code; and,
- WHEREAS, in addition to reevaluating the Six Mile watershed; and,
- WHEREAS, there currently exists a negative balance in the maintenance fund of \$5,055.09; and,
- WHEREAS, notification of the public hearing and base assessments were given, via U.S. Mail, to all landowners involved in said watershed.
- **THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners, does hereby approve the reevaluation of the assessment base from \$6,421.64 to \$50,353.86 and update the watershed boundaries from the 1960 petition Six Mile watershed map; and,
- **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners, does hereby authorize the changes of the watershed map; and,
- **BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED** that beginning with the 2024 tax collection year the Board authorizes a 5% maintenance fee to be charged to the watershed for the collection years 2024, 2025 and 2026 for the Six Mile Ditch Maintenance Fund; and,
- **BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED** that said Board certifies to Auglaize County Auditor said maintenance assessment base and acreage adjustments.
