8:30 a.m. Commissioner Spencer and Administrator Preston met with Project Manager Jason Solomon for monthly updates from the Maintenance Department.

9:20 a.m. Commissioner Bambauer moved to approve the resolutions as presented. Commissioner Spencer seconded the motion. The resolutions were then distributed for each Commissioner's vote and execution.
9:22 a.m. The Board and Administrator Preston met with IT Manager Scott Stanford and Ryan Miller for monthly updates from the Technology Department.
11:00 a.m. The Board, Administrator Preston and numerous County employees met with representatives from the State Auditor office for the annual exit conference.
11:52 a.m. Clerk Bobbi Donovan presented the minutes of the August 18, 2026 meeting.

- The minutes were approved with some clarification.

11:56 a.m. County Administrator Preston presented the following:

- Stated a meeting has been scheduled for August 25 to discuss staff structure at the Sheriff's Office.
- Shared details for an upcoming meeting regarding the sale of Neil Armstrong's childhood home.
- Discussed demo grant funding for 2027. Applications open on September 16, and the County will have to be designated as the lead entity on projects. The program will be statewide competitive with no guaranteed funding. Commercial projects need to be submitted individually while residential projects can be grouped together; scoring priority will go to demo leading to potential housing development.
- Reported workplace harassment training has tentatively been scheduled for October 20, 2026.
- Discussed a complaint received against the Auglaize County Council on Aging.

1:30 p.m. The Board and Administrator Preston met with Airport Manager Ted Bergstrom for the monthly update.
