INVITATION TO BIDDERS

Auglaize County Board of Commissioners (The Commissioners) is the governmental authority that owns the Auglaize Acres Nursing Home (herein called the "Owner"). Bidders for the property must submit the bids directly to the Commissioners' Office located in County Administration Building, 209 South Blackhoof Street, Room 201, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895, by 1:00 p.m. E.S.T. on October 5, 2017. Marcus & Millichap Real Estate Investment Services has been exclusively retained to assist in the sale of the facility. All Bidders must contact Marcus & Millichap Real Estate Investment Services, prior to submitting a proposal. Bidder may contact either Peyton C. In order to satisfy the requirement for an original and three copies, it is sufficient if a bidder simple fills in the blank portion of this Invitation to Bid as instructed (attaching extra pages where necessary), signs the Price Response Form, makes three (3) copies of the whole packet, and includes a bid bond (or earnest money deposit). The original copy of the Price Response Form must include an original signature.

Bidder may change or alter an original bid prior to the bid submission due date and time. However, no withdrawal or modification of a bid will be permitted after it has been submitted.

purchase the facility in accordance with the purchase agreement and to close the sale on or before December 31, 2017.

On October 5, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. E.S. T. the Bid Response Forms will be opened.

All bids will be evaluated according to the method set forth in Section 2.00 of the Invitation to Bid.

The contract(s) shall be awarded in accordance with Ohio Revised Code ("R.C") and/or other law as applicable, together with the terms and conditions set forth in the Invitation to Bid. The Commissioners shall award the bid to bidder them deem to be highest and best bidder.

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners may accept or reject any or all bids, in whole or in part, and may waive defects, if no prejudice results to the rights of another bidder or to the public.

When bidding, a bidder must deposit a bond, or a cashier's or certified check in the amount of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) (see Section 7.00, Notice of Bid Bond or Earnest Money Deposit).

If the bidder deposits money in lieu of a bond, such funds will be held in non-interest bearing escrow by the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners. Once the bid has been awarded, all escrow funds of unsuccessful bidders will be returned to them. Any earnest money deposit made by the Successful Bidder will remain in the on-interest bearing escrow until the purchase agreement is signed, at which time it will be applied toward the purchase price under that purchase agreement, described in Section 5.00 herein. Also at the time, any excess over the fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) will be applied to the overall earnest money deposit of two hundred dollars (\$200,000). If the Successful Bidder has submitted a bid bond, the bid bond will remain in force until the Successful Bidder signs the purchase agreement and pays the full two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) Earnest Money Payment under the purchase agreement.

The two hundred thousand dollars (\$200,000) Earnest Money Payment paid under the purchase agreement will not be kept in a separate account. It will however, be applied toward the purchase amount upon the successful closing of the sale contemplated herein, or otherwise disposed of or forfeited as provided in Section 1.13.
