



Ed Kersey began his 29 year career with Pratt Industries when the company came to America in 1988 as an Electrical Engineer specializing in instrumentation and control systems at the Macon Kraft Paper Mill in Macon, Georgia. Pratt Industries elected to construct a new 100% recycled greenfield paper mill on the outskirts of Atlanta, in the town of Conyers in 1993. This was the first of four paper mills Pratt would construct over the next 25 years. Ed was in charge of construction the largest corrugated box plant in the United States (more than 500,000 square feet) in Valparaiso, Indiana. He has also managed the construction of seven other new greenfield Pratt operations around the country.

He had the opportunity to lead the efforts in the design, construction and startup of the electrical and control systems in Pratt's first two mills. He was promoted to the overall project manager of the third U.S. mill in Shreveport, Louisiana in 2008 where he remained on as the General Manager of the facility. In this position, Ed was responsible for over 100 employees and annual sales in excess of \$250 million. He now leads the effort to construct the newest 100% recycled paper mill in the U.S. to be located in Wapakoneta, Ohio. The mill is planned to go into operation in the fourth quarter of 2019.

Ed received his formal education in New York and served in the U.S Navy for six years in the Middle East and Central America.


