# BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS AUGLAIZE COUNTY, OHIO

The Board of County Commissioners convened in regular session at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, December 1, 2015 in the Commissioners' Chambers with the following members present: Douglas A. Spencer, Don Regula and John N. Bergman. The meeting of the Board was called to order by President Spencer.

- 8:00 a.m. Commissioner Regula moved to approve the resolutions as presented.

  Commissioner Bergman seconded the motion. The resolutions were then distributed for each Commissioner's vote and execution.
- 8:35 a.m. Clerk Leffel read the minutes of the November 24, 2015 meeting and the minutes were approved with some clarification.
- 8:50 a.m. Clerk Leffel reported the following:
  - An applicant for a CHIP project exceeds the Residential Rehabilitation Standards (RRS) maximum amount for the CHIP funds available through the program.
  - Informed the Board that the cost allocation invoices are being sent out to Solid Waste and EMA for 2015.
  - She reviewed the meeting calendar for the next two weeks.
- 8:55 a.m. Administrator Preston conveyed the following:
  - Had an employee call on the medical necessity form for a chiropractor.
  - Reported that the crosswalk at the Courthouse is still being mistaken for a driveway into the parking lot.
  - Recycling Coordinator Scott Cisco is proposing some changes to the contract for the Education Specialist.
- 9:15 a.m. County Administrator Erica Preston and the Board met with Cooperative Extension staff for the monthly update. Cooperative Extension Staff present were: Jeff Stachler, Barb Hennard and Beth Miller.
  - Beth reported that the university is using a new branding logo and new signage will replace the outdated logo per the university's requirement.
  - Barb has been in several schools with Choose It Use It, a program dealing with healthy food choices, and working on Dining with Diabetes programs and that the Grand Lake Health Challenge is getting ready to start 2016.
  - Jeff reported that he had started the Dairy Luncheon series. He had a farm transition meeting with 36 participants. He is going to do a weed identification series. Spoke to the local Lions Club and will be speaking there next week. He attended the Trupointe and Bambauer field days. He is concluding a study dealing with yield limitations on soybeans. He is working on a water quality study. Did a weed survey in the county. Future Programs are the Auglaize County Agronomy Day which will be held in January this year instead of March. He will also put on a three hour fertilizer program for those who want to obtain their certification.

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Beth reported that they are getting ready for next year's fair. She is reviewing new rules coming down from the State. Beth reported that the participation of poultry projects for 2016 fair is still uncertain. She worked on the State's team for the Volunteer Handbook. A new state extension director will start after the first of the year.

The Engineer's estimate is \$55,444.30; Sand Ridge Excavating bid \$54,744.00; Braun Excavating bid \$52,300.30; Crooks Excavating bid \$52,031.77; Cy Schwieterman Inc. bid \$54,073.50. The bids will be reviewed by the County Engineer and a recommendation will be forthcoming. Chad Scott from the Engineer's Office was also present.
- 10:43 a.m. Erica reported a request has been received for Auglaize RLF dollars for a project. Erica is reviewing the request. She has contacted Acres administrator Kim Sudhoff about the wall pack lighting system.
