Dear Mr. Lenhart:

Hull & Associates, Inc. (Hull) is pleased to submit the attached memorandum regarding environmental monitoring services at the City of St. Marys (City) Landfill. The memorandum provides a list of activities that are required to be completed in 2009 to maintain minimal compliance with Ohio EPA regulations. As the actual Landfill owners, The City of St. Marys has also been provided this information and they have concurred with this approach.

In preparation of the costs associated with the proposed activities, Hull has locked in the same billing rates for 2009 as was used in 2008. We have developed a base proposal which maintains the minimum compliance efforts under Ohio EPA regulations and also provides additional sampling activities to comply with the June 2007 Work Plan that addresses outstanding Ohio EPA issues. After our earlier discussions with you and our recent discussions with the City, we do understand that resources for any additional work are very limited so we are only proposing a limited scope at this time.

In June of 2007, the City submitted a Work Plan to address Ohio EPA concerns regarding the need for further characterization of the landfill's significant zones of saturation. At that time, the City initiated a phased approach to address the issues by installing three of the seven proposed monitoring wells identified in the Work Plan and conducting limited groundwater sampling of the wells. To continue addressing the Work Plan, we have added a task for completion of three groundwater sampling events to establish background data sets for the three new wells.

Additional tasks that would satisfy the full intent of Work Plan and Ohio EPA expectations, but not included in the proposal, include installation and sampling of the four remaining monitoring wells outlined in the Work Plan. The costs associated with this initiative would range from \$20,000 to \$30,000. Also not included in the proposal are corrective measure initiatives and negotiations such as desktop remedial matrix analysis to evaluate remedial measures, continuation of ecological river study analyses, agency negotiations, and corrective measures plan updates. We can discuss these initiatives and how they relate to Ohio EPA issues in greater detail at your convenience.

Hull has implemented a sensible approach to ensure the City of St. Marys Landfill remains protective of human heath and the environment. In the past, Hull has advocated the completion of only the work required to protect the public health based on monitoring priorities and resource limitations. The reduced number of wells (seven) proposed in the June 2007 Work Plan versus the expanded number the Ohio EPA originally wanted (10 to 12) is the result of efforts to reduce the eventual number of wells in the monitoring network while maintaining adequate coverage of the significant zones of saturation in accordance with Ohio EPA regulations. This ongoing

approach has resulted in minimizing the number of wells and monitoring activities (and cost), while moving forward with negotiations with Ohio EPA regarding additional activities that they are requesting.

We look forward to continuing our work with the Auglaize County Commissioners and can discuss the required environmental monitoring activities and additional tasks in greater detail upon your request.

Hull & Associates, Inc. is pleased to submit this itemized scope of work for professional services for Baseline Environmental Monitoring at the St. Marys Landfill.

SCOPE OF WORK:

- 1. Completion of required January 2009 semi-annual and July 2009 annual groundwater detection and assessment monitoring.
- 2. Completion of annual leachate sampling activities, conducted concurrent with item #1 (above).
- Completion of two groundwater concentration resampling events at relevant well locations to reassess statistically significant concentrations in groundwater samples obtained from the January 2009 and July 2009 groundwater sampling events and completion of two alternate source demonstrations, if warranted.
- 4. Data management and report preparation/submittal for the January 2009 and July 2009 groundwater sampling activities (for items #1 and #2).
- 5. Completion of two semi-annual notifications of assessment activities and rate, extent, and concentration reports.
- Update and revision to the Detection Sampling and Analysis Plan and to the Groundwater Quality Assessment Plan to include available information to address several Ohio EPA deficiencies.
- 7. Limited compliance and procedural issues with Ohio EPA communications as related to their comments.
- 8. Completion of three groundwater sampling events (separate from Items #1 and #2 above) for exploratory monitoring wells MW-7, MW-8, MW-9 for required

background analysis. This item also includes preparation of three analytical summary reports for each event as required by Ohio EPA.

For this Scope of Work, Hull is estimating consultancy costs similar to the 2008 calendar year for groundwater monitoring and reporting. Although additional tasks are necessary per Ohio EPA regulations apart from the tasks identified above, we have only included the minimum requirements and background groundwater sampling in this Scope of Work.

Table 1 (attached) provides a listing of the tasks associated with this Scope of Work (Task I) along with background sampling and reporting tasks (Task II) that are required in order to meet objectives associated with obtaining an approved Detection Monitoring Plan. Tasks II is in direct reference to the facility's June 6, 2007 Work Plan developed to address significant groundwater zones of saturation. If the Auglaize County Commissioners chooses not to complete Task II, the 2009 Scope of Work and cost will be modified accordingly. Furthermore, initiatives related to monitoring well installation and corrective measures are not included in this Scope of Work. We can discuss these activities with you upon your request and amend the scope of work to include any portion of these additional activities.

The estimated analytical costs for the analytical laboratory currently contracted for the Site are not included in the cost of services provided by Hull. However, we have included the estimated analytical laboratory cost on the attached Table, located in the Subcontractor column. Note these rates include a significant discount negotiated by Hull based on our volume of work we do with this laboratory. We assume the analytical laboratory (Test America) will continue direct-billing to the Auglaize County Commissioners for their services. We look forward to meeting with you in the near future and working with you on the facility's monitoring program. If you have any questions, please contact me at your earliest convenience.

EDUCATION SPECIALIST AGREEMENT

By and between

BONNIE WURST, INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

And the

AUGALIZE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

This agreement entered into this 18th day of December 2008, by and between the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners, on behalf of the Auglaize County Solid Waste District, P. O. Box 603, St. Marys, Ohio 45885, hereinafter called the "Board" and Bonnie Wurst, hereinafter called the "Education Specialist."

Whereas, the Board, desires to enter into an Agreement with the Education Specialist for education services in recycling and litter prevention; and

Whereas the Education Specialist does provide professional services in this area for integrated solid waste management; and now, therefore.

Be it agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

Scope of Service.

- 1. Education Specialist agrees to perform the educational services for the county as directed by The Solid Waste Management District Coordinator, hereinafter "coordinator", of Auglaize County.
- 2. The Education Specialist will perform work to complete presentations and activities for teachers and students in the Auglaize County Schools, County Fair, Camps, special interest groups and any other event, at the request of the Coordinator, to educate the group or organization on recycling and litter prevention. Upon such request, the Education Specialist shall be responsible for all aspects of the presentation including scheduling.
- 3. The Education Specialist will provide the Coordinator with an updated written schedule of presentations each Monday morning. In the event of cancellation or rescheduling during the current week, the Education Specialist will notify the Coordinator to update the schedule.
- 4. The Education Specialist will provide the Coordinator with a monthly detailed billing statement, which will list the hours worked in each category of planning and teaching.
- 5. Subject matter and contents of the presentations will address recycling and litter prevention. The Board reserves the right to review such presentations to determine whether, in the opinion of the Board or its designee, the Coordinator, the results are effective.

6. The Education Specialist must provide the Board with proof that she is maintaining her qualifications as an education specialist by showing proof of attendance at appropriate educational seminars to acquire advance training in the recycling and litter prevention curriculum.

Duration of Agreement.

The Agreement will commence January 1, 2009 and terminate December 31, 2009 or upon expenditure of available funds, whichever occurs first.

In the event the funding for this program is not available from the Auglaize County Solid Waste District, the Board has no further obligation to fund this program and the Agreement shall terminate as set forth in the Termination clause of this Agreement.

Compensation.

The Education Specialist shall be compensated in an amount not to exceed Ten thousand eight hundred dollars (\$10,800.00) for work listed in the scope of services. The Education Specialist will invoice the County on a monthly basis for the hours worked in preparation and presenting. The hourly rate for the Education Specialist shall not exceed thirty dollars (\$30.00) per hour. The Education Specialist shall be responsible for monitoring ongoing billing statements to the Board and shall inform the Board and cease all work under this Agreement once the compensation cap listed above has been met.

The Education Specialist shall be responsible for travel to the locations of the presentations, seminars or activities, and the County will not compensate her for the same. The Education Specialist shall provide all materials and supplies necessary to complete the services under this Agreement, including, but not limited to office space, office supplies, mailing service, telephone access and the educational materials necessary to perform presentations and activities.

Independent Contractor.

The Education Specialist shall at all times be an independent contractor when acting under this Agreement. The Board is concerned with results, and the manner and methods used to achieve the desired results are solely within the Education Specialist's discretion, subject only to the terms of this Agreement and the requirements that state and federal law places upon the parties, and provided that the Education Specialist acts lawfully, fairly, and honorably.

The Education Specialist, as an independent contractor, agrees to assume responsibility for reporting, withholding, and/or paying any taxes as may be incident hereto, including, but not limited to federal, state, and local taxes; and, she hereby releases the Board, its officers, employees, and agents from any and all claims, demands, actions and causes of action

whatsoever as may arise or be attributed to days of service or compensation therefrom, holding and indemnifying the Board its officer, employees, and agents safe and harmless therefrom.

Responsibility of the Board.

The Board, through its Coordinator, may authorize the Education Specialist to participate in any other activity that is related to recycling/litter prevention management or educating and will benefit the interests of the County.

Reporting.

The Education Specialist will work cooperatively with the Board and Auglaize County Solid Waste Management District and upon request, the Education Specialist will provide appropriate reporting regarding education activities listed in the scope of service.

Agreement Modification.

This agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties and any changes or modifications to the Agreement shall be by agreement of the parties in writing and attached hereto.

Termination of the Agreement.

The Board may terminate this Agreement immediately, with or without cause, upon written notice to the Education Specialist.

In the event of such termination, any reports or information prepared by the Education Specialist under this Agreement shall, upon written request of the Board, become its property within thirty (30) days of receipt of said written notice. The Education Specialist shall forward the reports and information to the Board and the Education Specialist shall be entitled to receive equitable compensation for any work completed to the satisfaction of the Board.

The obligation to provide service under this Agreement may be terminated by the Education Specialist upon thirty (30) days written notice to the Board in the event of substantial failure by the Board to perform in accordance with the terms hereof through no fault of the Education Specialist.

Notices.

Any and all notices of intent to modify or terminate this Agreement by the Education Specialist shall be mailed to:

Hold Harmless/Indemnification.

The Education Specialist will defend, indemnify, protect, save, and hold harmless the Board its officers, employees, agents, and fiduciaries form any and all kinds of loss, claims, expenses, causes of action, costs, damages and other obligations, financial or otherwise, including court costs and attorney fees, arising from the performance under this Agreement, including but not limited to (a) negligent, reckless, or willful and wanton acts, errors, or omissions, including malfeasance, nonfeasance, or misfeasance by the Education Specialist, her agents, employees, licensees, contractors, or subcontractors arising from; (b) the failure of the education specialists, her agents, employees, licenses, contractors, or subcontractors, to observe the applicable standard of care in providing services pursuant to this Agreement; and (c) the intentional misconduct of the Education Specialist, her agents, employees, licenses, contractors or subcontractors that result in injury to persons or damage to property.

This clause shall survive the termination of the Agreement.

Insurance.

The Education Specialist shall be responsible for procuring and maintaining adequate insurance for herself and her employees including but not limited to Workers Compensation insurance and Automobile Liability Insurance.

Severability.

If any provision of this Agreement shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason the remaining provisions shall continue to be valid and enforceable. If a court finds that any provision of this Agreement is invalid or unenforceable, then such provision shall be deemed to be written, construed, and enforced as so limited.

Otherwise the stricken provision or part thereof shall be reformed to replace such stricken provision or part thereof with a valid and enforceable provision that comes as close as possible to expressing the intention of the stricken provision.

Counterparts; Captions.

This Agreement may be executed in several counterparts, each of which shall be regarded as an original and all of which shall constitute but one and the same Agreement. Captions have been provided herein for the convenience of the reader and shall not affect the construction of this Agreement.
