**SECOND AMENDMENT TO

This Second Amendment to the Grant Agreement (the "Second Amendment") is made and entered into by and between the **Ohio Department of Development** ("Grantor"), and **Auglaize County Board of Commissioners** ("Grantee") for the purpose of amending the Expiration Date for the **Building Demolition and Site Revitalization Program**.

Background Information

- A. Grantor and Grantee entered into a Grant Agreement effective January 1, 2022 (the "Original Agreement"). A First Amendment was subsequently executed.
- B. Both parties agree to extend the Expiration Date of the Agreement, as provided herein.

Statement of the Agreement

In consideration of the mutual covenants contained herein, the Grantor and Grantee agree that the Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

- 1. **Expiration Date.** The Expiration Date is amended to June 30, 2024.

General project scope includes assistance to low-moderate income (LMI) households with Private Owner Rehabilitation and Owner Home/Building Repair, and any other eligible activities located within Auglaize County, including the cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta.

Final Notice and Public Explanation of a Proposed Activity in a 100-Year/500-year Floodplain

To: All interested Agencies, Groups and Individuals

This is to give notice that the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners, City of St. Marys, and City of Wapakoneta have conducted an evaluation of the following proposed action as required by Executive Order 11988 (Floodplain Management), in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management and Wetlands Protection.

Auglaize County PY2022 Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) Program

Project Activities: Private Rehabilitation and Home/Building Repair. Source of Federal Funds: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Funds (HOME), and CDBG/HOME Housing Program Income. General project scope consists of private owner rehabilitation, owner home/building repair, and any other eligible activities to low-moderate income (LMI) households. For PY2022, Auglaize County and its partnering jurisdictions, the cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta, propose funding to assist approximately ten (10) private owner rehabilitation and approximately 14 owner home/building repair assistance projects. Proposed project activity located in Auglaize County (county-wide) and includes the partner cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta.

Auglaize County Board of Commissioners, City of St. Marys, and City of Wapakoneta have considered the following alternatives and mitigation measures to be taken to minimize adverse impacts and to restore and preserve natural and beneficial values:

- Alternatives considered were No Action; Develop a Different Site; and Development of This Site. “No Action” fails to address existing needs to provide housing assistance within the Auglaize County CHIP Service Area, which includes the partnering cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta. “Develop a Different Site” fails to address the needs of low-moderate income (LMI) households whose properties are located within the floodplain to have necessary rehabilitation/repair work completed. “Development of This Site” is the only practicable alternative. Projects, should they occur in the floodplain, should not negatively affect the floodplain since rehabilitation/repair activities involve existing housing structures on previously developed residential sites.
- Housing activities involve existing structures and/or on previously developed residential sites, and/or in residential areas. Project activities/improvements to be designed/performed per FEMA-NFIP standards/guidelines with the least amount of impact on the floodplain while accomplishing project goals. Floodplain disturbances will be minimal and temporary during construction. Accepted construction practices are to be employed to avoid sedimentation or improper infill of floodplain area during construction.
- Appropriate mitigation to occur and floodplain permits to be obtained as necessary. Affected property owners will be required to obtain flood insurance. Auglaize County, City of St. Marys, and City of Wapakoneta to comply with state and local floodplain protection procedures.

Auglaize County Board of Commissioners, City of St. Marys, and City of Wapakoneta have reevaluated the alternatives to building in the floodplain and have determined that it has no practicable alternative. On or about, but not before, **March 2, 2023**, the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners and Cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta will submit requests to the State of Ohio for the release of Federal funds under Section 104 (g) of Title I of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended; Section 288 of Title II of the Cranston Gonzales National Affordable Housing Act (NAHA), as amended; and/or Title IV of the Stewart B. Auglaize County PY2022 Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) Program

Source of Federal Funds: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership Funds (HOME), and CDBG/HOME Housing Program Income. The CHIP is also funded with State of Ohio Housing Trust Funds (OHTF). Auglaize County, as lead entity for the CHIP that includes the cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta as partnering jurisdictions, will use up to \$1,000,000 through its CHIP to provide Private Rehabilitation, Home/Building Repair, and any other eligible activities to low-moderate income (LMI) households within Auglaize County (county-wide), and including the partnering cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta. For PY2022, Auglaize County and its partnering jurisdictions, the cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta, propose funding to assist approximately ten (10) private owner rehabilitation projects (\$580,000 HOME); approximately 14 owner home/building repair projects (\$250,000 CDBG and \$50,000 OHTF); Fair Housing (\$7,500 CDBG); and General Administration \$112,500 (\$54,500 CDBG and \$58,000 HOME). Program includes HOME Housing Program Income from Auglaize County (\$80,457.86 HOME PI) and City of St. Marys (\$18,201.74 HOME PI) for Private Owner Rehabilitation projects. Multi-Year Project. Auglaize County (county-wide) and including the partnering cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta. Estimated Cost of Project: \$1,000,000 +/- per funding cycle.

The State of Ohio will accept objections to its release of funds and the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners and Cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta certifications for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners, City of St. Marys, or City of Wapakoneta; (b) the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners, City of St. Marys, or City of Wapakoneta has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development

process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the State of Ohio; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58, Sec. 58.76) and shall be addressed to Ohio Department of Development, Office of Community Development at OCD@development.ohio.gov. Potential objectors should contact the State of Ohio to verify the actual last day of the objection period.

WHEREAS, Auglaize County Department of Job & Family Services has submitted a Memorandum of Understanding which is between Auglaize County Department of Job & Family Services (ACDJFS), 12 N. Wood St., Wapakoneta, OH and the Auglaize County Children Services Agency for the purpose of accessing Kinship Caregiver funding through the Department of Job and Family Services Kinship Caregiver allocation to reimburse the Auglaize Count Children Services for allowable Kinship Caregiver expenditures authorized per Sub H.B. No. 541; and,

WHEREAS, it is understood Kinship Caregiver funds available to the ACDJFS are limited to the amount of funds allocated by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services each fiscal year. The ACDJFS will notify the Auglaize County Children Services each year of the amount of funds, if any, available to the Auglaize County Children Services. This amount may be amended at any time; and,

WHEREAS, the Auglaize County Children Services assumes full responsibility for billing the ACDJFS for allowable Kinship Caregiver expenditures incurred by the Auglaize County Children Services. All audit findings incurred for improper billings, unallowable services or program violations will be the sole responsibility of the ACDJFS per ORC 5108.12. The ACDJFS agrees to reimburse the Auglaize County Children Services for all audit findings within 30-day notice of such findings. This MOU shall be effective January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023.
