WHEREAS, Board of County Commissioners and other County Elected Officials and Department Heads have been reviewing the Section 5.03 Vacation language and would like to add the following sentence to the end of paragraph 2 of section 5:03 to the Personnel Policy Manual; and,

WHEREAS, the additional language for Vacation section 5.03.2:

Upon completion of eight (8), fifteen (15), and either twenty (20) years of service with Auglaize County or twenty-five (25) years of service, one (1) additional week (e.g. 40 hours) of vacation shall be added to the employees accrued vacation balance and the employee shall begin accruing vacation hours for the following year at the applicable higher rate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio does hereby authorize the additional language to the Personnel Policy Manual for the 5.03. Vacation, effective January 1, 2021 as stated above; and,


