**IN THE MATTER OF FINDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT AND AMENDMENT OF THE KOENIG DITCH PROJECT; PETITIONED BY ROGER MACK AND OTHERS; SETTING DATE TO RECEIVE ENGINEER'S REPORTS ON SAID PROJECT.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners, in Resolution #22-501, dated November 1, 2022 set January 26, 2023 at 1:30 p.m., for the First Hearing of the petition of the Koenig Ditch Project, the Board met in the Assembly Room – 2nd Floor at the Administration Building and conducted the hearing by causing the petition to be publicly read to those present by TJ Place for the County Engineer's Office; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board finds that due and legal notice has been given in the manner and for the length of time required by law, to all owners of land affected by said improvement; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board has made a virtual view of the proposed improvement on December 22, 2022 and has heard either in person or by counsel all evidence offered by any owner of land for or against the granting of the proposed improvement, or for or against the granting of any laterals, branches, spurs, or change of route, course, termini, or manner of construction described in the petition, or any application therefore; and,

**WHEREAS**, the County Engineer's Preliminary Report has determined that the route and termini of the proposed improvement meets the prayer of the petition and that there are no reasonable alternative routes; and,

**WHEREAS**, the cost of the proposed improvement is less than the benefits derived.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby direct the County Engineer to proceed with the necessary survey for the proposed improvement, perform the necessary engineering calculations, develop the necessary plans for the drainage system and structures including profiles showing the cuttings and gradient of the improvement, create maps showing the location of the land proposed to be assessed and make an estimate of the cost of the construction of the improvement. The Engineer' Report shall include the actual construction cost estimate, the cost of engineering, and the cost of notices, publication and other incidental expenses; and set proper construction stakes, and perform such other duties as required by Section 6131.14 of the Ohio Revised Code; and,

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The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 2nd day of February, 2023.

**WHEREAS**, Auglaize County has applied for Federal funding for housing assistance from the State of Ohio through the Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program (CHIP); for ten (10) client families within the County; and,

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the County to enter into an agreement with a company which can complete pest inspections and treatment for the residences if necessary; and,

**WHEREAS**, Auglaize County and Kleinfelder, the Administrator of the County's CHIP program, have chosen Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. to perform said inspections, which will be supervised by Kleinfelder rehabilitation specialist; and,

**WHEREAS**, an agreement for this pest inspection service has been presented to the Board of County Commissioners showing the term of the agreement retroactive from December 1, 2022 through February 28, 2025; the service fee is determined by the location of the inspections within the county with a total anticipated cost ranging from \$110.00; and,

**WHEREAS**, that Board is requested to approve this agreement and execute same.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby approve the Service Agreement between Auglaize County and Buckeye Exterminating Inc. for pest inspections of properties being rehabilitated through the P.Y. 2022 CHIP program; and,

**AGREEMENT**  
**for Pest Inspection Services between Auglaize County, Ohio,**  
**and Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. of Ottoville, Ohio**

This agreement is entered by and between **Buckeye Exterminating, Inc.** (“Consultant”), 24018 US State Route 224, Ottoville, Ohio 45876, and the **Auglaize County Board of County Commissioners**, Auglaize County, Ohio (“County”), Auglaize County Board of Commissioners, 209 South Blackhoof Street, Room 201, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895.

Whereas Auglaize County has applied for funds for housing assistance for their respective locale from the State of Ohio through the PY2022 Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) program for the period from December 1, 2022, through February 28, 2025; and

Whereas Auglaize County will be providing private-owner rehabilitation assistance in the form of a declining/forgivable loan to income-eligible families using funds from the CHIP program; and

Whereas the State requires that all homes receiving private-owner rehabilitation assistance utilizing CHIP program funds be inspected for pests and receive treatment if needed.

**Therefore, it is mutually agreed as follows:**

1. Auglaize County agrees to utilize the professional services of Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. of Ottoville, Ohio, (hereinafter referred to as Pest Consultant), to assist with the Auglaize County PY2022 CHIP project.
2. That Pest Consultant shall provide the County with the following professional services:

**I. Pest Inspection:**

James Good and Ted Gawronski, Rehabilitation Specialists with Kleinfelder, Inc. (the County’s CHIP consultant), will contact Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. with each private-owner rehabilitation participant and request an inspection of the property.

Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. will contact the CHIP participant to set up an appointment for the pest inspection.

Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. will provide the original pest report and invoice for services addressed to Auglaize County and email a copy of the same to Kleinfelder, Inc., [accounts@kleinfelder.com](mailto:accounts@kleinfelder.com), and to [bcowell@kleinfelder.com](mailto:bcowell@kleinfelder.com); for payment and CHIP client file.

Pest inspection services will be exempt from sales tax charges given the County’s tax-exempt status.

**II. Pest Treatment:**

If treatment is necessary, Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. will contact the rehabilitation specialists, James Good and/or Ted Gawronski, to provide the cost of treatment and schedule/coordinate the said work at the property.

The invoice for treatment services, if any, will be sent to Kleinfelder, Inc. for inclusion in the project contract and payment.

### III. County/ Kleinfelder, Inc. Responsibilities:

Participants receiving CHIP private-owner rehabilitation will be referred to the Pest Consultant by Kleinfelder, Inc.

The anticipated number of clients to receive pest inspection services is listed below:

#### **Auglaize County – ten (10) client families**

Auglaize County will provide through Kleinfelder, Inc. to the Pest Consultant a service fee of **\$110.00 per property inspected**. If anything, such as an insect issue or a wood-destroying insect is found the **\$110.00 inspection fee** will be deducted from the cost of treatment. It is anticipated that **ten (10) clients** will be assisted during this contract period for an anticipated cost of **\$1,100.00 (10 x \$1,100)**. Kleinfelder, Inc. will make payments to the Pest Consultant upon receipt of an itemized invoice.

### IV. Contract Term

That this Agreement between Buckeye Exterminating, Inc. and Auglaize County will be in effect through **February 28, 2025**.

That if the work performed by the Pest Consultant is not performed in a manner satisfactory to Auglaize County, then the County retains the right to terminate this Agreement at any time. This Agreement may also be terminated by either party for any reason with fourteen (14) days written notice. Unless the termination is the fault of the Pest Consultant, the Pest Consultant shall be compensated for all services performed prior to receipt of written notice from the County of such termination.

### General Terms

#### V. Assignment

The Consultant shall not assign any duties or compensation received under this Agreement without the express prior written consent of the County.

#### VI. Modification of Agreement

Any alteration or modification of the terms or conditions of this agreement must be in writing and assigned by the parties.

#### VII. Nondiscrimination Clause

It is understood and agreed that, in compliance with the provisions of Chapter 125.111, Revised Code of Ohio, the Consultant, any subcontractor, or any person acting on behalf of a contractor or subcontractor will not:

- a) Discriminate by reason of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, age, national origin, or ancestry against any citizen of the state in the employment of labor or workers who is qualified and available to perform the work to which the employment relates.
- b) Discriminate in any manner against or intimidate any employee hired for the performance of work under this contract on account of race, color, religion, sex, handicap, age, national origin, or ancestry.



### **VIII. Independent Contractor Clause**

It is hereby agreed by and between the parties that the relationship between the Consultant and the County shall be that of an independent contractor and that no employer-employee or agent-principal relationship is created by this contract. The County is interested in the results achieved and the conduct and control of the work will lie solely with the Consultant.

The Consultant is not entitled to any of the benefits the County does provide its employees. It is further understood that the County does not agree to use the Consultant exclusively. Moreover, it is understood that the Consultant is free to contract for similar services to be performed for other parties while he is under contract with the County. The Consultant shall be solely liable and responsible to pay all required taxes and other obligations, including, but not limited to, withholding and social security.

### **IX. Contract Employees and Subcontractors**

The contractor agrees that its employees and its independent contractors/subcontractors are not and will not become employees of Auglaize County when providing the goods and performing the services that are the subject of the Agreement. The contractor also agrees that it will take all steps necessary to ensure that the persons or entities providing the goods and performing the services that are the subject of this Agreement will not do so in such a way as to be regarded as ‘public employees’ as defined in OAC 145-1-42.

### **X. Defend, Indemnify and Hold Harmless Clause**

The Consultant agrees that it will defend, indemnify and hold Auglaize County, its officers, employees, agents, and assigns harmless from any liabilities, claims, or demands arising out of work performed pursuant to this contract from persons who are not a party thereto and who claim or allege any personal injury or death or any damage to their property due to the intentional or negligent acts of the Consultant’s or its officers, employees or agents. The County shall give timely notice and accord to the Consultant the right to defend and settle all such claims.

### **XI. Proof of Insurance**

The service provider will procure and maintain at its own cost for the duration of this Agreement the following insurance:

- a) Commercial General Liability insurance policy in the amount of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$1,000,000 in the aggregate.
- b) Business Auto Liability insurance policy in the amount of at least \$1,000,000 combined single limit, on all owned, non-owned, leased, and hired automobiles
- c) Professional Liability (errors and omissions) insurance of at least \$1,000,000 per claim and \$1,000,000 in the aggregate, if applicable.
- d) Umbrella and excess liability insurance policy with limits of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$1,000,000 in the aggregate, above the commercial general, professional liability, and business auto primary policies.
- e) Workers’ Compensation insurance and the statutory limits required by the Ohio Revised Code.

The service provider further agrees to name the Board as an additional insured on all contracts of insurance for the duration of this Agreement. The endorsement form and the certificate of insurance shall state the following: “Auglaize County Commissioners, and its respective officials, employees, agents, and volunteers are endorsed as additional insured as required by Contract on the commercial general, business auto and umbrella/excess liability policies.” All certificates and endorsements must be received by the Board before work pursuant to this Agreement commences.

**XII. Child Support Clause**

The Consultant declares that its principal officers, directors, shareholders, and/or partners are current with any court-ordered child support payments pursuant to the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners Resolution No. 112-2041.

**XIII. Governing Law**

This Agreement shall be interpreted, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio. Exclusive jurisdiction and venue for any claim or action arising out of or relating to this Agreement shall be in the State courts located in the State of Ohio.

**XIV. Waiver**

Any waiver by either party of any provision or condition of this Agreement shall not be construed or deemed to be a waiver of any other provision or condition of this Agreement, nor a waiver of a subsequent breach of the same provision or condition.

**XV. Severability Clause**

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or portion of this agreement shall for any reason be held invalid, unenforceable, or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.

**XVI. Entire Agreement**

This Agreement, the schedules and all attachments designated on the face of the agreement as included shall constitute the entire agreement of the parties and shall supersede all prior negotiations, proposals, and representations, whether written or oral.
