

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 23rd day of February, 2021.

Commissioner Bambauer moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

- WHEREAS**, the Sheriff of Auglaize County and the Sheriff of Mercer County wish to come together in agreement to house one another's inmates in certain circumstances deemed appropriate by each Sheriff; and,
- WHEREAS**, these circumstances may include but are not limited to the separation of prisoners from other prisoners and/or staff as needed; and,
- WHEREAS**, it is agreed by both County Boards that there will not be a per diem rate charged for holding each other's prisoner; however, each county will be responsible for their own inmate's medical costs; and,
- WHEREAS**, housing may be declined based on the inmate's mental and/or medical condition and whether they pose a serious safety and security risk; and,
- WHEREAS**, the Sheriff's will decide on housing for any unforeseen circumstances such as short term overcrowding, building repair/maintenance, and or remodel; and,
- WHEREAS**, either Sheriff may be contacted on any final housing decision.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that said Board authorizes the Memorandum of Understanding between the Auglaize County Sheriff and the Mercer County Sheriff for housing inmates as mentioned above; and authorizes the execution of said Memorandum of Understanding.

Memorandum of Understanding

This memorandum of understanding, made and entered into the _____ day of February, 2021 by and between the Mercer County Commissioners and the Auglaize County Commissioners.

Whereas, due to many different factors, including but not limited to the safety and security interest of the inmate, staff, or the jail itself, there are time when it is in the best interest to house an inmate in another county.

Whereas, the Sheriff of Mercer County and the Sheriff of Auglaize County wish to come together in agreement to house one another's inmates in certain circumstances deemed appropriate by each Sheriff.

Now therefore be it mutually agreed between the parties as follows:

1. These circumstances may include, but are not limited to, the separation of prisoners from other prisoners and/or staff member(s) as needed.
2. It is agreed by both County Boards that there will not be a per diem rate charged for holding each other's prisoners; however, each county will be responsible for their own inmate's medical costs.
3. Housing may be declined based on the inmate's mental and/or medical condition and whether they pose a serious safety and/or security risk.
4. The Sheriff's will decide on housing for any unforeseen circumstances such as short-term overcrowding, building repair/maintenance, and/or remodel.
5. Either Sheriff may be contacted for a final housing decision.
6. This agreement may be terminated by either party by 30 days written notice to the other party.

IN THE MATTER OF SETTING A DATE AND TIME TO CONDUCT A PUBLIC HEARING CONCERNING A REQUEST FOR A ROAD NAME CHANGE IN UNION TOWNSHIP.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 23rd day of February, 2021.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on February 16, 2021, the Board of County Commissioners received a petition signed by two county property owners living on Stiles Road, in Union Township which is located between Blank Pike Road and State Route 65, is one mile in length and runs through section 21 in Union Township; said petition was submitted to Commissioners' Office by the Keith and Diane Fahnccke, petitioners; and,

WHEREAS, petition document reads: "The undersign, Keith and Diane Fahnccke, owners of all land adjacent to Stiles Road, in Union Township, between SR #67 and Blank Pike; hereby request to the Board of County Commissioners to change the name of Stiles Road to "Fahnccke Road"; and,

WHEREAS, the County Engineer provided a letter dated January 27, 2021 that was received from Keith and Diane Fahnccke in which it stated: With utmost respect to our county's roads and byways; we are requesting that the one mile stretch of Stiles Road, running South between State Route 57 and Blank Pike Road, be changed to "Fahnccke" Road. Since the humble beginnings in the year 1957, when the Fahnccke family (Richard and Rosalyn Fahnccke) embarked on a journey to bring their family to the present sight of Stiles Road, and continued the dairy operation until 1975 and grain farmed thereafter until their deaths in 2014 and 2018 respectively. They created a legacy with hard work and determination. It would give us no great jot to further their legacy than to have the Stiles Road name changed to "Fahnccke" Road in their honor; and,

WHEREAS, attached is a petition signed by two landowners who currently reside on that roadway, asking the Board of County Commissioners to officially adopt "Fahnccke" as the name of the roadway; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 5541.04, the Board of County Commissioners is to hold a public hearing concerning this request for a road name change before a decision can be made on this petition.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio does hereby set March 23, 2021, at 10:00 a.m. as the date and time to hold a public hearing in its office in the Auglaize County Administration Building, 209 S. Blackhoof Street, concerning the petition to have the name of Stiles Road, in Union Township, changed to "**Fahnccke Road**".
