The Board of County Commissioners convened in regular session at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, February 26, 2026 in the Commissioners' Chambers with the following members present: David Bambauer, Douglas A. Spencer and John Bergman. The meeting of the Board was called to order by President Bergman.

- 8:45 a.m. Commissioner Bambauer moved to approve the resolutions as presented.
Commissioner Spencer seconded the motion. The resolutions were then distributed for each Commissioner's vote and execution.
- 9:05 a.m. Clerk Donovan read the minutes of the February 24, 2026 meeting.
 - The minutes were approved.
 - Clerk Donovan discussed upcoming CDBG training and requested days off.
- 9:15 a.m. County Administrator Preston presented the following:
 - Reported that the DD Shared Services Agreement between Allen and Auglaize DD Boards will be ending soon.
 - Reported amended W-2's were issued to county employees that earned qualified overtime in 2025; discussed protocol on issuing amended W-2's.
 - Reported the CDBG Allocation draft contract was received for projects in St. Marys and Minster.
 - Reported there will be a Target of Opportunity monitoring visit on April 16.
 - Reported asbestos removal for the 120 W. Main St., Cridersville project will move forward within the next two weeks. The award for demolition will be completed.
 - Reported Waynesfield will host a grand opening park dedication on July 25, 2026 and have invited the commissioners to speak at the event.
 - Reviewed the information from the state-wide dog warden conference call.
 - Reviewed information from the virtual Sheriff's Office meeting with Datamark regarding Next Gen 911 and county data.
 - Reported Auglaize County will be hosting an introductory meeting with ODOT, District 1 on March 25.
 - Discussed pledge renewal to Dolly Parton Imagination Library. The Board agreed to make an additional pledge.
 - Discussed tree removal needed at Auglaize Industries. The Board authorized the quote from Alltree Tree Care.
- 10:05 a.m. The Board and Administrator Preston met with Andrew Baumer, County Engineer and Kyle Perry to discuss sanitary labor reimbursement.
- 11:25 a.m. Dave Bambauer traveled to the Armstrong Air & Space Museum for the monthly update.

1:15 p.m. With no further business to bring before the Board, President Bergman adjourned the meeting for the day.






