WHEREAS, on January 6, 2021 the Drainage Technician TJ Place filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, a petition signed by Hugh Seibert; Salem Township Trustees and others as petitioners, to petition to install subsurface tile, make lateral connections to existing drainage lines, install fittings and elbows, and place catch basins or manholes as required to satisfy the prayer of the Petition. If and when the project has been completed, the landowners shall have the drainage improvements place on Permanent County Maintenance as per Section 6131 and 6133 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Said petition being located in Section 3 of Salem Township, Auglaize County, Ohio;

Commencing on the west side of Seibert Road being at a point approximately 1,700 feet north of the centerline of Salem-Noble Road and approximately 25 feet west of Seibert Road; thence easterly in direction under Seibert Road with new subsurface drainage pipe in the same general direction as an existing 18" clay subsurface tile for approximately 50 feet; thence turning and continuing north across the Phyllis Ramga property and across the Hugh and Nancy Seibert property in the same general direction as an existing 18" and 20" clay subsurface tile and there to terminate at an open ditch at a point approximately 1,600 feet south of the centerline of Barber-Werner Road and approximately 25 feet east of Seibert Road. 
