WHEREAS, Auglaize County Department of Job & Family Services has submitted a Memorandum of Understanding which is between Auglaize County Department of Job & Family Services (ACDJFS), 12 N. Wood St., Wapakoneta, OH and the Auglaize County Family and Children First Council (FCFC), for the purpose of the ACDJFS to provide funding to the Auglaize County FCFC; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 307.110 of Amended Substitute House Bill 166 of 133rd General Assembly, the purposes of the multi-system youth program and funding are to prevent custody relinquishment to the public children services agency (PCSA) solely for the purpose of a child obtaining needed treatment; support the care of children in the custody of a PCSA for congregate care; and to provide the services and supports necessary to ensure the child's successful transition from a congregate care facility following discharge; and,

WHEREAS, the Auglaize County DJFS will transfer to the Auglaize County FCFC a minimum of twelve percent (12%) in State Multi System Youth Allocation funding received in SFY25 to be deposited into the FCFC flexible funding account. This is allowable transfer under Statutory Authority: 5101.14, section 307.110 of Am. Sub. H.B. 166 of the 133rd General Assembly.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby approve and authorize the MOU for the Auglaize County DJFS to provide funding as stated above for SFY25 to be deposited into the Auglaize County FCFC flexible funding account; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board ratifies the execution of said Memorandum of Understanding (MOU).

These funds will be for the purpose of enhancing the well-being of Ohio's children and families by building community capacity, coordinating systems and services and engaging families. All disbursements from this funding will be approved by the FCFC Board. This is an allowable transfer under O.A.C 5101:9-6-19 (F)(3).

IN THE MATTER OF FIXING DATE AND TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE SCHOLL DITCH AND TO REEVALUATE THE MAINTENANCE BASE AND UPDATE THE WATERSHED MAP ON SAID DITCH PROJECT.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 16th day of January, 2025.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, County Engineer Andrew Baumer, Drainage Engineer Sam Philipot and Drainage Technician TJ Place met with the Board on October 31, 2024:

In 2001, the Scholl Ditch underwent improvements after being petitioned through the Auglaize Soil and Water, and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Engineer's Office. This 3,755 tile ditch drains a watershed of 4271 acres and in 2001, cost \$34,198.78 for the installation of the drainage tiles. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 24 years of maintaining the project with the 2001 base amounts, our department has reassessed the outside watershed boundary, updated parcel land use, and adjusted the total base cost to reflect current market prices. These updates have affected both the total project cost and the individual base costs for the parcels within the watershed.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$83,435.55. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 3,755 feet of the Scholl Ditch as done in 2001 for \$34,198.78. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 24 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this tile ditch such as tile blowouts or replacement and erosion control.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the Scholl watershed and we are asking the Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a maintenance hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code. This department will prepare and mail the notices to the property owners within the watershed.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners, of Auglaize County, Ohio does hereby set **February 25, 2025 at 2:30 p.m.** in the Chambers located at the Administration Building, 209 S. Blackhoof Street, Wapakoneta, Ohio for the Public Hearing on the reevaluation of the Scholl Ditch maintenance base and update the watershed map.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, County Engineer Andrew Baumer, Drainage Engineer Sam Philipot and Drainage Technician TJ Place met with the Board on October 31, 2024:

In 2011, the Mack Ditch underwent improvements as a group project, and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Engineer's Office. This 245 open ditch drains a watershed of 328 acres and in 2011, cost \$5,000.00 for the installation of the open ditch. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 14 years of maintaining the project with the 2011 base amounts, our department has reassessed the outside watershed boundary, updated parcel land use, and adjusted the total base cost to reflect current market prices. These updates have affected both the total project cost and the individual base costs for the parcels within the watershed.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$14,724.13. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 245 feet of the Mack Ditch as done in 2011 for \$5,000.00. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 14 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this tile ditch such as tile blowouts or replacement and erosion control.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the Mack watershed and we are asking the Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a maintenance hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code. This department will prepare and mail the notices to the property owners within the watershed.
