The Board of County Commissioners convened in regular session at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, January 19, 2012 in the Commissioners Chambers with the following members present: Douglas A. Spencer, Don Regula and John N. Bergman. The meeting of the Board was called to order by President Spencer.

  Commissioner Regula seconded the motion. The resolutions were then distributed for each Commissioner's vote and execution.
- 8:20 a.m. Clerk Leffel read the minutes of the January 17th, 2012 meeting. The minutes were approved as read.
- 8:30 a.m. Staff meeting was held.
- 9:00 a.m. Assistant Administrator Hensley and the Commissioners met with Cameron Ruppert and Nate Schumacher for the IT monthly update. They reviewed some alternatives in working with CMI, software consultants, to help with shared services with the law enforcement agencies in the county. A feasibility study could be done in round one of a grant application that the county is looking at utilizing. Nate and Cameron also attended a seminar at Perry Corp on the Smart Board usage. IT personnel also observed a demonstration of the FTR (For the Record) equipment for the courtrooms.
- 10:00 a.m. The Commissioners opened bids for the Lowry Ditch Project. Two bids were received from J & M Excavating Inc. \$21,830.40 and Cy Schwieterman Inc. \$22,025.00. The bids will be reviewed by the SWCD staff and the Engineer's office. The Commissioners will await a recommendation and then award the contract. T.J. Place was present from the SWCD office.
- 11:00 a.m. The Commissioners held the public hearing on the vacation of a portion of road right of way on County Road #33A just west of Wapakoneta by the cemetery. Engineer Doug Reinhart was the only person present for the hearing. There were no objections received by the Engineer or the County Commissioners. Engineer Reinhart gave his report and indicated that the plat and legal description of said portion will be filed in the Auglaize County Recorder's office.
- 1:00 p.m. The Commissioners and Assistant Administrator met with Sean Stroh, Airport Manager, for the monthly update. He reviewed some items that may need to be upgraded in the future i.e. changing from single to dual fuel dispensing systems.
- 2:15 p.m. Treasurer, April Bowersock, met with the Commissioners to discuss her shortfall in the salary line item for 2012 due to her granting a pay increase for two employees in her office in November 2011. The funds were available because she had an employee retire earlier in the year. The Commissioners appropriated a 2% increase in the 2012 salary line item based on the current employee roster.
- 3:45 p.m. Assistant Administrator Hensley reviewed the resolutions to be considered at the January 24, 2012 meeting.
- 4:00 p.m. The Commissioners discussed the mileage reimbursement rate to be used for 2012.
