WHEREAS, In order to position our Region to take full advantage of technical resources and funding available through EDA, it is essential that the Dayton Region pursue the establishment of an Economic Development District (EDD); and,

WHEREAS, the Miami Valley Regional Planning Commission will be the lead agency for the EDD and, in partnership with the Dayton Development Coalition, will be responsible for updating and implementing the *Dayton Region Economic Development Strategy*; and,

FINDING OF NO SIGNIFICANT IMPACT

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners has determined that the proposed Demolition/Clearance activity at 107 East Bremen Street, New Knoxville, Ohio will have no significant impact on the human environment. Therefore, an Environmental Impact Statement under the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 (NEPA) is not required.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners by U.S. mail or email at the addresses above. All comments received before **February 4, 2022** will be considered by the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds. Comments should specify which Notice they are addressing.

ENVIRONMENTAL CERTIFICATION

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners certifies to the State of Ohio that David Bambaer in his capacity as President of the Board of County Commissioners consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. The State of Ohio's approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities and allows the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

The State of Ohio will accept objections to its release of funds and the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners certification for a period of fifteen days following the anticipated submission date or its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners; (b) the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the development process have committed funds, incurred costs or undertaken activities not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by the State of Ohio; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality.
