KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That Auglaize County Commissioners, the Grantors, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$ 1.00) and for other good and valuable consideration to them by the City of Wapakoneta, the Grantee, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and release to the said Grantee, its successors and assigns forever, a perpetual easement for the sole purpose of installation and maintenance of electrical components or services, in, upon and over the lands hereinafter described:

Being located through parcel number B07-310-002-00 in the Southeast ¼ of Section 31, Town 5 South, Range 6 East, Duchouquet Township, Auglaize County, Ohio, and being more particularly described as follows:

Commencing from a railroad spike (found) at the intersection of the centerlines of Dearbaugh Avenue and Fairview Drive;

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners will be receiving Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) from qualified service offers to perform necessary function related to its PY2024 Community Housing Impact and Preservation Program (CHIP). Scope of work includes development of grant application, convening the Auglaize County Housing Advisory Committee as required for grant application, preparing an environmental review record, carryout out a fair housing program, performing residential property inspections (including lead-based paint risk assessments and clearances), overseeing pest inspection, and administration and implementation of the CHIP Grant.
