APRON REHABILITATION – PHASE 2 NEIL ARMSTRONG AIRPORT NEW KNOXVILLE, OHIO

Sealed proposals will be received by the Auglaize County Commissioners, "Owner", at the Office of the Airport Manager, Neil Armstrong Airport, 7776 OH-219, New Knoxville, OH 45871, until **2:00 p.m. (local time)**, on the **21st day of February, 2024** and then will be publicly opened and read aloud at the Neil Armstrong Airport. Any bids received later than 2:00 p.m. will be returned unopened.

DESCRIPTION OF WORK: Work for which proposals are to be received is for the rehabilitation of the aircraft apron at the Neil Armstrong Airport including concrete pavement repair, concrete crack repair, concrete pavement patching, concrete pavement removal and replacement, and necessary incidentals to complete the work as detailed on the Contract Drawings and specified in the Contract Documents titled "Apron Rehabilitation – Phase 2". The contractor shall provide all labor, equipment, and material necessary to complete the work. All work is located at the Neil Armstrong Airport, 7776 OH-219, New Knoxville, OH 45871.

OHIO REQUIREMENTS: Each bid shall be accompanied by bidder's financial statement, a statement of experience, a proposed plan or plans for performing the public work, and the equipment that bidder has available for the performance of the public work.

Wage rates on the project shall not be less than the prescribed scale of wages as determined in accordance with the most recent Prevailing Wage Rates of Labor for the State of Ohio.





In the Matter of the EWALD DITCH SINGLE County Ditch Petitioned for by SCOTT

KOHLER, ROBERT BERG and others.

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into on this 25th day of January, 2024.

By and between the County Commissioners of AUGLAIZE COUNTY, Ohio, and hereinafter designated as "First Party," and SAND RIDGE EXCAVATING of 20251 RD I-17 CLOVERDALE, OHIO 45827 hereinafter designated as "Second Party."

WITNESSETH, THAT SAID "SECOND PARTY," For and in consideration of the sum of TWO HUNDRED SIXTY SEVEN THOUSAND TWO HUNDRED SIXTY and 20/100 (\$267,260.20) Dollars, to be paid as hereinafter specified, hereby agree to furnish unto said "First Party." all the necessary materials, and do all the work and labor required to construct the EWALD DITCH improvement petitioned for by SCOTT KOHLER, ROBERT BERG and others, in accordance with plans, drawings and specifications for the same hereto attached, which plans, drawings and specifications are hereby declared to be a part of this contract.



WHEREAS, County Engineer Andrew Baumer, Drainage Engineer Sam Philipot and Drainage Technician TJ Place met with the Board on January 18, 2024:

In 1995, the Cogan Ditch was requested to be placed under the county's maintenance program, reconstructed and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Highway Department. This 1,426 tile ditch drains a watershed of 115 acres and in 1995, cost \$2,929.80 for the installation of the drainage tiles. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 29 years of our department maintaining this project and using the 1995 construction cost as the base amount, this amount is no longer sufficient enough to keep the account stable due to inflation.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$7,200.63. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 1,426 feet of the Cogan Ditch as done in 1995 for \$2,929.80. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 29 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this tile ditch such as tile blowouts or replacement and erosion control.

WHEREAS, County Engineer Andrew Baumer, Drainage Engineer Sam Philipot and Drainage Technician TJ Place met with the Board on January 18, 2024:

In 1989, the Fisher Ditch was petitioned through Soil and Water Conservation District, reconstructed and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Highway Department. This 620 feet open ditch drains a watershed of 68 acres and in 1989, cost \$4,002.33 for the installation of the open ditch. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 35 years of our department maintaining this project and using the 1989 construction cost as the base amount, this amount is no longer sufficient enough to keep the account stable due to inflation.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$10,579.03. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 620 feet of the Fisher Ditch as done in 1989 for \$4,002.33. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 35 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this tile ditch such as tile blowouts or replacement and erosion control.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the Fisher watershed and we are asking the Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a maintenance hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code.
