NexGen EAP PLUS – PARTICIPANT AGREEMENT

1. General Terms

This Participant Agreement is made effective by and between the Mental Health & Recovery Services Board of Allen, Auglaize & Hardin Counties (“MHR SB”) with offices located at 529 S Elizabeth St, Ste 200, Lima, OH. 45801 and Auglaize County (“Client”) with a mailing address of 209 S. Blackhoof Street, Room 201, Wapakoneta, OH 45895. The Agreement also references participation and services of Employee Network Inc. (“ENI”) as the servicing EAP.

By signing this agreement, the Client is accepting the terms and conditions as outlined below.

The company representative signing below is obligated to share the terms and conditions of this agreement with other company representatives as needed (e.g., corporate officers).

2. Term and Termination

This Agreement shall commence as of the signature date below and **shall be negotiated each year** on the anniversary date, assuming all program requirements are met (see section 5, “Program Requirements” below).

This Agreement is terminable by either party for convenience. Termination of the agreement, by either party, requires notice of not less than ninety (90) business days, in writing, to the other party.

If an eligible employee and/or their dependent is using EAP services at the time of termination of their employment, ENI will continue to provide services until conclusion of those EAP services. After date of termination of employment, the eligible employee and/or dependents will have a thirty (30) day grace period to contact ENI and initiate services.

3. Eligible employees and dependents

- a. “Eligible employees” having access to the EAP are those employed by the Company on a fulltime and/or part-time basis in a continuing position authorized by the company. Eligible employees do NOT include any person whose services are provided under an agreement between the Client and a temporary employment agenda of similar person or organization.
- b. “Eligible dependent(s)” having access to EAP services include:
 - domestic partners of eligible employees
 - each eligible employee’s spouse
 - each eligible employee’s dependent children from birth to age 26 and/or
 - unmarried children, residing with parent, regardless of age, who have a diagnosed medical disability

Under this agreement, this service is for eligible employees and their dependents (as defined above). Through census updates and the Business Navigator, individuals who are no longer eligible will be identified and offered alternative treatment avenues.

4. EAP Service and Other Provisions

ENI will provide all services of the NexGen EAP Plus program as described in Exhibit A, “Summary of Services: NexGen EAP Plus.”

5. Program Requirements

In order to have access to the NexGen PLUS EAP program, Clients must agree to the following:

- a. Data Reporting – With support from the EAP Business Navigator, gather and report company data regarding
 - Number of employees eligible for EAP services (monthly)
 - Employee turnover rate (monthly)
- b. Quarterly Meetings – Participate in a quarterly meeting with the EAP Business Navigator to, for example,
 - Review EAP utilization
 - Troubleshoot any customer service issues
 - Receive education about how to refer for mandatory services
 - Discuss other available training, educational, and other services
- c. Program Promotion - Permit corporate name to be referenced in press releases, articles, etc., unless pre-negotiated with the Board. Exceptions can be made by submitting a written request to MHR SB.
- d. Satisfaction Survey- Complete a brief satisfaction survey once a year.
- e. Internal Support- With support from the EAP Business Navigator
 - Commit to sharing monthly newsletters and other EAP news with employees.
 - Strive to include EAP benefit reminders into staff meetings, employee communications

6. Fees

- a. NexGen PLUS EAP Services – For the term of this Agreement, fees to cover all services of NexGen EAP Plus **will be paid to ENI by MHR SB** at the rate of \$1.27/per eligible employee per month. MHR SB shall not be responsible to pay for any ancillary services (telehealth etc.) A Client desiring to receive those ancillary services shall contract with and pay ENI separately. ENI shall not be obligated to provide said ancillary services to Clients without a separate signed agreement.

At the expiration of this Agreement, Clients will be given the opportunity to contract for EAP services directly with ENI, at a negotiated rate, if they are interested.

7. Misc.

- a. HIPAA Compliance

Definitions

HIPAA - Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996.

Protected Health Information (PHI) - individually identifiable health information that is transmitted by electronic media; maintained in any electronic media such as magnetic tape, disc, optical file; or transmitted or maintained in any other form or medium, i.e., paper, voice, fax, Internet, etc.

PHI generally includes such individually identifiable health information as name, address, phone number, fax number, date of birth, social security number, or other unique identifying number(s).

Minimum Necessary – the minimum amount of PHI necessary to achieve the purpose of the use or disclosure.

The parties shall comply with the requirements of the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act of 1996 (HIPAA). Each party shall take necessary reasonable steps to comply with HIPAA requirements, including the following:

If one of the parties agrees to use or disclose protected health information on behalf of the other party, both parties will enter into a business associate agreement prior to such use or disclosure. The elements of such agreements shall conform to HIPAA requirements.

The parties shall cooperate in determining how information will be transmitted to conform with requirements related to electronic data interchange (EDI). If necessary, the parties will enter into a Trading Partner Agreement, which defines the duties of the parties for EDI transmissions.

The parties shall cooperate assessing joint security issues in order to allow the parties to conform to security requirements. If necessary, the parties will enter into appropriate agreements in accordance with HIPAA requirements, which will address joint security issues.

b. Misc.

The parties may not assign this Agreement without prior written consent of the other, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld. This Agreement shall be binding upon and enforceable by the parties and their respective successors and permitted assigns.
