MARYS AND WAPAKONETA AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THE OHIO BUILDING CODE WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID VILLAGES AND CITIES.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 5th day of January, 2017.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio is in receipt of eight (8) agreements; and,

WHEREAS, these agreements are entered into by and between the Board of Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio acting for and on behalf of Auglaize County, Ohio, hereinafter referred to as "County" and the Villages of Buckland, Cridersville, Minster, New Bremen, New Knoxville and Waynesfield, hereinafter referred to as "Villages" and the Cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta hereinafter referred to as "Cities"; and,

WHEREAS, the agreements are attached and on file and made a part of this resolution as if fully rewritten. Agreements will be maintained until no longer of administrative value; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Building Standards of the State of Ohio has heretofore certified the Miami County Building Department to exercise enforcement authority in accordance with the Ohio Building Code to become effective August 4, 1988, as set forth in said Board's certification dated November, 1985; and,

WHEREAS, it is anticipated that an agreement will be entered between Auglaize County and Miami County, with both counties agreeing to have Miami County exercise enforcement authority of the Ohio Building Code in Auglaize County, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Building Standards has formulated and adopted the Ohio Building Code containing regulations governing the erection, construction, repair, alteration and maintenance of all buildings or classes of buildings specified in Section 3781.06 of the Revised Code of Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, it is necessary in accordance with law that the Ohio Building Code be administered and enforced within the limits of the "Villages" and "Cities"; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Building Standards is being petitioned to create Auglaize County Building Department and to certify the "Villages" and "Cities" with the condition that the County, by and through an agreement with Miami County, perform all inspections and exercise the enforcement authority in accordance with the Ohio Building Code; and,

WHEREAS, the County desires and is willing to administer and enforce the Ohio Building Code within the limits of said Villages and Cities pursuant to its authority so to do contained in Chapter 3781 of the Revised Code of Ohio and as granted by the Ohio Board of Building Standards; and

WHEREAS, the following "Villages" and "Cities" have heretofore passed its Resolutions to enter into an agreement with Auglaize County for the enforcement of the Ohio Building Code within the limits of said "Villages" and "Cities" whereby the Miami County Building Department through its agreement with the County will exercise all enforcement authority necessary within the said "Villages" and "Cities":

**APPROVING THE AGREEMENTS WITH THE "VILLAGES" AND "CITIES" AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY TO ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THE OHIO BUILDING CODE WITHIN THE LIMITS OF SAID VILLAGES AND CITIES.

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Villages of Buckland, Cridersville, Minster, New Bremen, New Knoxville and Waynesfield and Cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta hereby grant to County full authority to do all things necessary to exercise all enforcement authority, accept and approve plans and specifications and make inspections in accordance with pertinent provisions of Chapters 3781 and 3791 of the Ohio Revised Code and any rules adopted thereunder.
2. The County accepts the authority and responsibility to carry out the terms of this agreement.
3. The County shall have full authority to do all things necessary to administer and enforce the Ohio Building Code within the limits of the "Villages" and "Cities". All the "Villages" and "Cities" and the County acknowledge that pursuant to the Agreement between Auglaize and Miami County for the enforcement of the Building Code, Miami County shall receive and retain all permit and inspection fees authorized by the State of Ohio for such purposes, while the Agreement between Auglaize and Miami County remains in effect.
4. The effective date for which the County shall begin to perform its duties under the terms of these agreements shall be the date of certification by the Ohio Board of Building Standards or some mutually agreed to date thereafter, and this agreement shall thereafter continue in full force and effect until either of the parties shall give written notice to the other of its intention to terminate the agreement, which may be for any reason, except that the agreement shall not terminate in less than sixty (60) days, absent written agreement of both parties, following the receipt of such notice by either of the parties.
5. These agreements shall be deemed to authorize the County to administer and enforce for the Villages or Cities any amendments or additions to the Ohio Building Code hereafter adopted by the Board of Building Standards pursuant to the authority granted by said Board by Chapter 3781 of the Revised Code of Ohio at all times after said Board shall have adopted such amendments or additions.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio hereby approves the terms of said agreements with the Villages of Buckland, Cridersville, Minster, New Bremen, New Knoxville and Waynesfield and the Cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta to administer the Ohio Building Code and ratifies the execution thereof.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners hereby authorizes Miami County representatives to make application to the Ohio Board of Building Standards to approve creation and certification of the Auglaize County Building Department and sub department certification as provided herein.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners met with representatives from various villages, municipalities and contractors in Auglaize County to discuss the possibility of contracting with Miami County to provide services in accordance with the statute for commercial building permits within the limits of Auglaize County; and,

WHEREAS, each Village/City Council has provided a implemented resolution/ordinance and an executed agreement to authorize the Board of Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio acting for and on behalf of said Village/City Council to enter into an agreement with Miami County that designates Miami County to enforce the Ohio Building Code for Auglaize County; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of Miami County Commissioners and the Miami County Building Department presented to the Board Auglaize County Commissioners an agreement that hereby grants to Miami County full authority to do all things necessary to exercise all enforcement authority, accept and approve plans and specifications and make inspections necessary within the territorial boundaries of Auglaize County, Ohio in accordance with pertinent provisions of the Ohio Building Code, other pertinent provisions of the Ohio Administrative Code and specifically, to accept and approve plans and specifications, and make inspections in accordance with pertinent provisions of Chapters 3781 and 3791 of the Ohio Revised Code and any Rules adopted thereto, except plumbing; and,

WHEREAS, the effective date for which the Miami County shall begin to perform its said duties under terms of this agreement shall be the date of certification by the Ohio Board of Building Standards or some mutually agreed to date thereafter.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners , Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby approve and enter into the agreement with Board of Miami County Commissioners that the Miami County Building Department perform all inspections and exercise the enforcement authority for commercial building permits in accordance with the Ohio Building Code; and,

AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this ____ day of _____, _____ by and between the Board of Miami County Commissioners, hereinafter referred to as "Miami County", and the Board of Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio and in Municipalities and Villages, hereinafter referred to as "Auglaize County".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Board of Building Standards of the State of Ohio did on November 15, 1985 certify the Miami County Building Department to exercise enforcement authority in accordance with the Ohio Building Code (effective August 4, 1986) and as amended from time to time; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Building Standards has formulated and adopted the Ohio Building Code containing regulations governing the erection, construction, repair, alteration and maintenance of all ~~non-residential~~ buildings or classes of buildings specified in Section 3781.06 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary in accordance with law that the Ohio Building Code be administered and enforced within the territorial limits of Auglaize County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Building Standards is being petitioned to certify the County of Auglaize County, Ohio with the conditions that the Miami County Building Department perform all inspections and exercise the enforcement authority in accordance with the Ohio Building Code; and

WHEREFORE, Miami County desires and is willing to administer and enforce the Ohio Building Code within the territorial limits of said Auglaize County pursuant to its authority to do so contained in Chapter 3781 of the Ohio Revised Code and as granted by the Ohio Board of Building Standards; and

WHEREFORE, Auglaize County, Ohio has heretofore passed its Resolution No. ~~17-008~~ on the 5th day of January, 2017 authorizing Auglaize County, Ohio through its Board of County Commissioners and its Clerk to enter into an agreement with Miami County for the enforcement of the Ohio Building Code within the territorial limits of Auglaize County whereby the Miami County Building Department shall exercise all enforcement authority necessary within the said Auglaize County; and

WHEREAS, Miami County has on the _____ day of _____, adopted its resolution authorizing Miami County to enter into said agreement with Auglaize County, Ohio, for the purposes aforesaid;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES AS FOLLOWS:

1. Auglaize County, Ohio hereby grants to Miami County full authority to do all things necessary to exercise all enforcement authority, accept and approve plans and specifications and make inspections necessary within the territorial boundaries of Auglaize county, Ohio in accordance with pertinent provisions of the Ohio Building Code, other pertinent provisions of the Ohio Administrative Code for non-residential construction and specifically, to accept and approve plans and specifications, and make inspections in accordance with pertinent provisions of Chapters 3781 and 3791 of the Ohio Revised Code and any Rules adopted thereto, except plumbing.
2. Miami County accepts the authority and responsibility to carry out the terms of this agreement.
3. Miami County shall have full authority to do all things necessary to administer and enforce the Ohio Building Code within the territorial limits of Auglaize County, Ohio and in consideration therefore Miami County shall retain all permit and inspection fees authorized by the State of Ohio for such purposes.
4. The effective date for which Miami County shall begin to perform its duties under the terms of this agreement shall be the date of certification by the Ohio Board of Building Standards or some mutually agreed upon date thereafter, and this agreement shall thereafter continue in full force and effect until either of the parties shall give written notice to the other of its intention to terminate this agreement, which may be for any reason, except that this agreement shall not terminate in less than sixty (60) days following the receipt of such notice by either of the parties.
5. This agreement shall be deemed to authorize Miami County to administer and enforce for Auglaize County any amendments or additions to the Ohio Building Code hereafter adopted by the Board of Building Standards pursuant to the authority granted by said Board by Chapters 3781 and 3791 of the Ohio Revised Code at all times after said Board shall have adopted such amendments or additions.
