The Board of County Commissioners convened in regular session at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, July 21, 2026 in the Commissioners' Chambers with the following members present: John N. Bergman, Douglas A. Spencer and David Bambauer. The meeting of the Board was called to order by President Bergman.

- 8:00 a.m. Commissioner Bambauer moved to approve the resolutions as presented. Commissioner Spencer seconded the motion. The resolutions were then distributed for each Commissioner's vote and execution.
- 8:31 a.m. Clerk Bobbi Donovan read the minutes of the July 16, 2026 meeting.
  - The minutes were approved with some clarification.
  - The BOCC calendar was reviewed.
- 8:37 a.m. County Administrator Preston presented the following:
  - Presented a revised work schedule proposal from the IT Department.
  - Discussed mold mitigation needed at the airport, along with quotes received for the work. The Board approved moving forward with the corrective actions and instructed Administrator Preston to submit to insurance.
  - Informed the Board of grant applications and a potential property purchase by Heritage Trails Park District. The Board agreed to review a letter of support for this project.
  - Discussed a recent uptick of county employees requesting prior service credit.
  - Discuss a request to purchase a new computer for Judge Spees office.
  - Discussed representation needed for an upcoming meeting in St. Marys regarding the Generation vs. Designation Fee.
  - Discussed a budget increase request from a county office.

- #26-302 Matter of authorizing the grant application to the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice

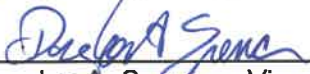

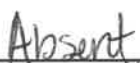

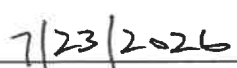
