

If We agree to the following conditions: The support structure for the mailbox installation shall be no larger than a 4" x 4" treated wooden post or no larger than a 2" diameter steel post. Post weights are not to exceed 2.6 pounds per foot, and shall not be buried no deeper than 24" and backfilled with either native soils or gravel only (no concrete). Frigid temperatures as well as snow and ice removal of peratinos of highway crews will crack, fracture, or even shattered these types of mailboxes. The preferred installation would be to use an aluminum mailbox on a steel sign post. The County Engineer is not responsible for loss or damage to mailboxes caused from snow and ice removal from the roadways during the winter season, unless the mailbox was physically hit by a snowplow. That traffic will be maintained at all times, unless permission is granted by the County Sheriff's Office about pending work that may cause a disturbance to in-season school bus routes, safety, fire and rescue services, or ambulatory services. That lights, signs barricades and, if necessary, flagmen and watchmen, will be placed on the job for the protection of traffic at all times, day and night, during the time this work is being done and that instructions			Date:	
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
NOTES:

- 2) The actual sign and lettering is provided by the Township Trustees for the township in which the installation is being made.










MAILBOX APPROACH
