The Board of County Commissioners convened in regular session at 8:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 10, 2026 in the Commissioners' Chambers with the following members present: David Bambauer and Douglas A. Spencer. John Bergman was excused. The meeting of the Board was called to order by Vice President Spencer.

- 8:00 a.m. Commissioner Bambauer moved to approve the resolutions as presented.  
Commissioner Spencer seconded the motion. The resolutions were then distributed for each Commissioner's vote and execution. Resolution #26-098 was pulled and will be re-submitted for consideration at a future time.
- 8:34 a.m. Clerk Donovan read the minutes of the March 5, 2026 meeting.
  - The minutes were approved.
  - BOCC calendar was reviewed.
- 8:43 a.m. County Administrator Preston presented the following:
  - Reported the 1<sup>st</sup> Public Hearing for General CDBG held on Monday, March 9, 2026 was well attended. It was followed by a Fair Housing Session.
  - Discussed a recommendation received from Solid Waste for a concrete project at their facility. More details will be obtained.
  - Discussed details from a webinar with a budget company. The software is a good solution but not necessarily the price point the county would benefit from at this time.
  - Reported updates on cost allocation payments made by the dog warden.
  - Reported the company performing demolition of the Acres will accommodate the request for public access to bricks from the building. The company will have a designated area outside of the fenced in demolition area for first come, first served access to the bricks.
  - Discussed a request for drone practice within the Acres site before demolition. The Board is willing to approve with some conditions.
  - Reported demolition to the Acres will begin within the next two weeks.
  - Reported the viewing of the historical video and slides has been fixed in the main hallway of the Administration Building.
  - Reported a request for a subordination agreement to a CHIP project in St. Marys. The Board is willing to consider this request and directed the paperwork to be completed.
  - Discussed projects to be included in the capital budget requests that are due this week.
  - Reported the ARPA close out is due this week and is completed.
  - Reported tasks are still being done for a recent public records request.
- 9:30 a.m. The Board and Administrator Preston met with JFS Director Julie Gossard for her monthly update.

1:00 p.m. The Board and Administrator Preston met with Lisa Marino and colleagues from Victress Health to learn more about the services offered by Victress.


The following Resolutions were presented to the Board, for its consideration (the entire texts of same are documented in the Board's Journal by the Clerk of the Board):

2:00 p.m. With no further business to bring before the Board, Vice President Spencer adjourned the meeting for the day.


