NOTICE OF FIRST PUBLIC HEARING
PY2024 BIENNIAL COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) PROGRAM

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners intends to make application to the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) to access funding from the approximately \$45 million of funds available under the PY2024 Biennial Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program, a federally funded program administered by the State of Ohio.

The County, including its villages and cities of St. Marys and Wapakoneta, is eligible to apply for funding under the following programs: Community Development Program; Community Housing Impact & Preservation Program (CHIP); Economic Development & Public Infrastructure Programs; Residential Public Infrastructure Grant Program; Flexible Grant Programs; Training & Technical Assistance Funds; Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDs (HOPWA) Program; Supportive Housing, Homeless Crisis Response, & Housing Assistance/Development Grant Programs; and, Any/New Programs Announced Under the CDBG, HOME, and OHTF Programs. Competitive programs Auglaize County may be eligible for in PY2024 include Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) funding (up to \$1,000,000), Critical Infrastructure (up to \$500,000), and Flexible Grant Program (up to \$250,000); providing the County meets applicable program requirements.

Eligible county entities interested in discussing potential projects or applying for competitive open-cycle programs should contact the Board of Commissioners Office as soon as possible. Projects will be reviewed, ranked, and selected based on compliance with a CDBG National Objective; inclusion in the Auglaize County Community Development Implementation Strategy (CDIS); application completeness; number of beneficiaries served; and number of previous awards. The County's Community Development open-cycle competitive grant applications are due to ODOD by June 12, 2024.

The first of the required two public hearings for this comprehensive grant program will be convened in Commissioners Chambers at the Auglaize County Administration Building, 209 South Blackhoof Street, Room 201, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895, an ADA-accessible facility. The hearing shall commence at **10:00 AM on Monday, March 25, 2024**, to provide citizens with pertinent information about the CDBG program, including an explanation of eligible activities and program requirements. The CDBG program can fund a broad range of activities including economic development projects; street improvements; water supply, drainage, and sanitary sewer improvements; park acquisitions and improvements; demolition of unsafe structures; and rehabilitation of housing and neighborhood facilities. Activities must be designed to meet one of the CDBG National Objectives: to primarily benefit low- and moderate-income persons, or aid in the prevention or elimination of slums and blight; or meet an urgent need of the community; and comply with applicable Program Objectives as outlined in the Ohio Consolidated Plan. A Fair Housing training session will be held immediately following the public hearing.

Citizens are encouraged to attend the first public hearing to provide input on the County's CDBG Program. Should any participant require auxiliary aids due to disability or non-English languages, please contact this office at least one week prior to the hearing date to ensure needs will be accommodated. Anyone wishing to submit written comments prior to the hearing may direct them to the Auglaize County Board of Commissioners at the address above.

To assist the County in preparing its Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) Application and Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing, interested political jurisdictions and agencies within Auglaize County are invited to attend a planning meeting to discuss CHIP activities/resources and issues/topics related to the fair housing analysis to be held on **Monday, March 25, 2024, at 10:30 AM** at the County Administration Building Assembly Room, 2nd Floor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners, does hereby authorize the changes to the watershed map; and,


BE IT STILL FURTHER RESOLVED that said Board certifies to Auglaize County Auditor said maintenance assessment base and acreage adjustments.
