The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 18th day of March, 2025.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Auglaize County has received an agreement from ODOT for the Bridge and Culvert Load Rating Project. This is an 80% grant up to \$54,880.00 and paid with Federal Funds. The completion date for the improvement will be set by ODOT; and,

WHEREAS, County Engineer Andrew Baumer has presented to the Board of County Commissioners from such agreement, requesting that the Board ratify his signature and approve the agreement.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners does hereby approve the ODOT / County Local Program Agreement (LPA) agreement for up to \$54,880.00 for the Bridge and Culvert Load Rating Project to improve safety in Auglaize County, Ohio; and,

LPA BRIDGE LOAD RATING AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT is made by and between the State of Ohio, Department of Transportation, hereinafter referred to as ODOT, 1980 West Broad Street, Columbus, Ohio 43223 and the Auglaize County Engineer, 1014 S. Blackhoof Street, P.O. Box 59, Wapakoneta, OH 45895-0059, hereinafter referred to as the LPA.

1. PURPOSE
 - 1.1 The National Transportation Act has made available certain Federal funding for use by local public agencies. The Federal Highway Administration (hereinafter referred to as FHWA) designated ODOT as the agency in Ohio to administer FHWA's Federal funding programs.
 - 1.2 Section 5501.03(A)(3) of the Ohio Revised Code provides that ODOT may coordinate its activities and enter into contracts with other appropriate public authorities as necessary to carry out its duties, powers and functions, provided the administration of such projects is performed in accordance with all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations with oversight by ODOT.
 - 1.3 The Bridge and Culvert Load Rating Project ("PROJECT") has been selected for funding, having received FHWA approved authorization.
 - 1.4 The purpose of this Agreement is to set forth requirements associated with the Federal funds available for the PROJECT and to establish the responsibilities for the local administration of the PROJECT.
2. LEGAL REFERENCES
 - 2.1 This Agreement is established pursuant to Section 5501.03(A)(3) of the Ohio Revised Code and all applicable federal, state, and local laws and regulations.

3. FUNDING

- 3.1 The total cost for the PROJECT is estimated to be \$ 68,600. ODOT shall provide to the LPA 80% percent of the eligible costs, up to a maximum of \$ 54,880 in Federal funds. This maximum amount reflects the funding limit for the PROJECT set by the applicable Program Manager.
- 3.2 This Agreement operates on a reimbursement basis only. The costs must first be incurred by the LPA. Costs claimed for reimbursement are to be true costs incurred in executing the PROJECT and are to be eligible, allowable allocable, reasonable, necessary, and consistent. Final determination of cost eligibility shall rest with ODOT.
- 3.3 Invoices for reimbursement may be submitted on a quarterly basis, unless other arrangements have been agreed upon by the parties. All invoices must include detailed expenditures and documentation as required by ODOT. For reporting purposes, quarters are defined as ending with the last day of the following months: December, March, June, and September.
- 3.4 All invoices shall be paid within thirty (30) days following receipt. If any invoice is not acceptable, the time for prompt payment is suspended. ODOT will either promptly provide the LPA with a clear statement regarding any specific cost ineligibility, or inform the LPA of any invoice deficiencies that

must be eliminated prior to acceptance, processing, or payment by ODOT. If such notification is sent, the required payment date shall be thirty (30) days after receipt of the corrected invoice.

3.6 Within thirty (30) days after completion of all work under this Agreement, the LPA shall submit to ODOT a detailed final bill, based on work order accounting covering the actual costs of work performed, and showing where accounts may be audited.

3.7 All billing shall conform to ODOT Specifications for Consultant Services requirements and procedures. Any reimbursable travel-related expenses shall be paid in accordance with the requirements and rates as set forth in Rule 126-1-02 of the Ohio Administrative Code, as updated from time to time.

4. OBLIGATIONS OF THE LPA

4.1 The LPA shall engage the services of a consultant to perform the services provided in this Agreement. Consultant selection procedures must comply with sections 153.65 through 153.71 of the Ohio Revised Code, and Federal Regulation 23 CFR 172.

4.2 The LPA shall submit to ODOT a copy of all contracts and procurements with any one vendor or consultant in excess of a combined total of \$5,000. All such contracts and procurements shall be subject to the same laws, regulations, and policies that govern this agreement.

4.3 The LPA shall review all consultant invoices for the scoped services to ensure accuracy in both amount and in relation to the progress made. The LPA shall submit to ODOT a written request for reimbursement of the Federal share of the expenses involved, according to the cost sharing provisions of this Agreement, attaching copies of all source documentation associated with pending invoices or costs in accordance with the Funding Section noted above.

4.4 The LPA shall submit a final comprehensive annual activity report to ODOT no later than June 30, 2025. All final reports shall be accompanied by a properly documented final claim for reimbursement.

5. EXPIRATION AND TERMINATION PROVISIONS

5.1 This Agreement commences on the date of the last signature here to and shall expire on June 30, 2025.

5.2 This Agreement and obligation of the parties herein may be terminated by either party with thirty days written notice to the other party. In the event of termination, the LPA shall cease work, terminate all subcontracts relating to such terminated activities, take all necessary or appropriate steps to limit disbursements and minimize costs, and furnish all data results, reports, and other

materials describing all work under this contract, including without limitation, results accomplished, conclusions resulting therefrom, and such other matters as ODOT may require.

5.3. In the event of termination, the LPA shall be entitled to compensation, upon submission of a proper invoice, for the work performed prior to receipt of notice of termination, less any funds previously paid by or on behalf of ODOT. ODOT shall not be liable for any further claims, and the claims submitted by the LPA shall not exceed the total amount of consideration stated in this agreement. In the event of termination, any payments made by ODOT in which services have not been rendered by the LPA shall be returned to ODOT.

5.4. If in the event that any dispute arises between ODOT and the LPA concerning interpretation of, or performance pursuant to this Agreement, such dispute shall be resolved solely and finally by the Director of Transportation.

6. GENERAL PROVISIONS

6.1 This Agreement and any attachments constitute the entire Agreement between the parties. All prior discussions and understandings between the parties are suspended by this Agreement. Neither this contract nor any rights, duties or obligation described herein shall be assigned by either party hereto without the prior express written consent of the other party. Any change to the provisions of this agreement must be made in a written amendment executed by both parties.

6.2 The LPA shall be audited in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code and/ or OMB Circular A-133. If the audit is not conducted by ODOT, ODOT shall receive a copy of the Auditor's report within 30 days after receipt by the LPA.

6.3 This Agreement shall be construed and interpreted and the rights of the parties determined in accordance with the laws of the State of Ohio.

6.4 It is expressly understood by the parties that none of the rights, duties, and obligations described in this Agreement shall be binding on either party until all statutory provisions under the Ohio Revised Code, including but not limited to Section 126.07, have been complied with and until such time as all necessary funds are made available to the State by FHWA.

6.5 Any person executing this Agreement in a representative capacity hereby warrants that he/she has been duly authorized by his/her principal to execute this Agreement on such principal's behalf.

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IN THE MATTER OF FIXING DATE AND TIME FOR A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE ROEDIGER #2 DITCH AND TO REEVALUATE THE MAINTENANCE BASE AND UPDATE THE WATERSHED MAP ON SAID DITCH PROJECT.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 18th day of March, 2025.

Commissioner Spencer moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, County Engineer Andrew Baumer, Drainage Engineer Sam Philipot and Drainage Technician TJ Place met with the Board on October 31, 2024:

In 1986, the Roediger #2 Ditch underwent improvements after being petitioned through the Auglaize Soil and Water, and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Engineer's Office. This 441 feet of open ditch and 1,359 feet of tile that drains a watershed of 175 acres and in 1986, cost \$7,237.61 for the installation of the drainage tiles. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 39 years of maintaining the project with the 1986 base amounts, our department has reassessed the outside watershed boundary, updated parcel land use, and adjusted the total base cost to reflect current market prices. These updates have affected both the total project cost and the individual base costs for the parcels within the watershed.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$16,913.04. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 441 feet of open ditch and 1,359 feet of tile of the Roediger #2 Ditch as done in 1986 for \$7,237.61. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 39 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this tile ditch such as tile blowouts or replacement and erosion control.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the Roediger #2 watershed and we are asking the Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a maintenance hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code. This department will prepare and mail the notices to the property owners within the watershed.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners, of Auglaize County, Ohio does hereby set **July 1, 2025 at 1:30 p.m.** in the Assembly Room located at the Administration Building, 209 S. Blackhoof Street, Wapakoneta, Ohio for the Public Hearing on the reevaluation of the Roediger #2 Ditch maintenance base and update the watershed map.

WHEREAS, County Engineer Andrew Baumer, Drainage Engineer Sam Philipot and Drainage Technician TJ Place met with the Board on October 31, 2024:

In 1986, the Greve Ditch underwent improvements after being petitioned through the Auglaize Soil and Water, and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Engineer's Office. This 1,807 feet of tile and 1,807 of waterway that drains a watershed of 167 acres and in 1986, cost \$8,124.68 for the installation of the drainage tiles. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 39 years of maintaining the project with the 1986 base amounts, our department has reassessed the outside watershed boundary, updated parcel land use, and adjusted the total base cost to reflect current market prices. These updates have affected both the total project cost and the individual base costs for the parcels within the watershed.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After reevaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$36,630.43. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 1,807 feet of tile and 1,807 feet of waterway of the Greve Ditch as done in 1986 for \$8,124.68. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 39 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance strictly on this tile ditch such as tile blowouts or replacement and erosion control.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the Greve watershed and we are asking the Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a maintenance hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code.
