IN THE MATTER OF GIVING A SIX-MONTH EXTENSION FOR LANDOWNERS TO COMPLETE THE WORK FOR THE SHINDOLLAR SINGLE COUNTY DITCH PROJECT BY SEPTEMBER 1, 2019.

The Board of Auglaize County Commissioners met in regular session on the 19th day of March, 2019.

If and when the project has been completed, the landowners shall have the drainage improvements placed on Permanent County Maintenance as per Section 6131 and 6133 of the Ohio Revised Code; and,

WHEREAS, on February 12, 2019 the viewing of the Shindollar Ditch was held at the proposed construction site on Deep Cut Road, 1/2 mile west of Eisley Road, Spencerville, Ohio; and,

WHEREAS, on March 12, 2019 the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, opened the First Hearing for the Shindollar Single County Ditch Project. During the course of the First Hearing the Drainage Technician, TJ Place, per the wishes of the attending landowners, recommended that this First Hearing be postponed and reconvened in six months, to allow the opportunity for the construction of this project to be performed on a private basis and the work to completed in accordance with the county's standards; and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, being respectful of the wishes of the landowners and County Engineer did thereby adjourn the First Hearing in accordance with ORC Section 6131.10 and grant a six-month extension for the landowners to have the ditch construction privately done for said Shindollar Ditch Project.

Dear Ms. Preston:

Pursuant to the Ohio Development Services Agency Office of Community Development (ODSA-OCD) requirements for submission of an updated Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing by July 1, 2019, Poggemeyer Design Group, Inc. (PDG) is providing this letter contract for execution. PDG proposes to provide professional planning services to assist Auglaize County with preparation of its PY19 Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing as required by the State (hereinafter referred to as the "project").

If there are any other project requirements beyond those normally related to the State of Ohio CDBG program, the County shall be responsible for providing a detailed summary of the requirements for the project, including any special considerations or services needed. The fee listed below shall be renegotiated in that instance. In addition, the County will provide all pertinent existing data related to this project to PDG.

Basic services provided under this contract will consist of the following items:

1. **Preparation of Auglaize County's PY19 Analysis of Impediments (AI) to Fair Housing.** Specified costs associated with the preparation of Auglaize County's AI as required for all participating grantees of the state's CDBG Community Development Allocation Program and as stipulated in Grant Agreements between the County and the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA). The AI, at minimum, must include the following:
 - a. An introduction and general summary of the Analysis of Impediments.
 - b. A concise overview of jurisdictional background data for the county; to include demographic data, income characteristics, employment and transportation profile, housing profile and applicable maps.
 - c. An evaluation of the county's current fair housing profile to include number and type of housing discrimination complaints and identification of other fair housing concerns or problems.
 - d. Identification of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice to include the sale or rental of housing, provision of housing brokerage services, provision of financing assistance for dwellings, public policies and actions concerning community development and housing activities such as HOME, NSP, multi-family rehabilitation, and activities causing

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displacement, which affect opportunities of minority households to select housing inside or outside areas of minority concentration.

- e. Assessment of current public and private fair housing programs/activities in Auglaize County.
- f. Conclusions and recommendations to include impediments, fair housing concerns, or problems, changes or remedies needed to overcome identified impediments, and a plan of action with a timetable or schedule to address identified impediments.

The fee for the preparation of Auglaize County's Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing is a lump sum fee not to exceed **\$10,000** which includes reimbursable expenses.


PDG will provide monthly invoices for services, with payments being due within thirty (30) days of receipt to avoid potential finance charges. PDG will begin work on the project upon receipt of this executed letter contract and will complete the PY19 CDBG Allocation Program Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing by July 1, 2019, for submission to the State as required.

This letter contract, with Exhibits A (1 page) and B (1 page), represents the entire agreement between PDG and the County in respect to the project and may be modified only by written agreement of both parties and may be terminated by either party upon seven (7) days written notice to the other party. If this letter contract accurately reflects your understanding of our agreement, please sign the original and enclosed copy of this letter contract in the space provided below and return the original to PDG. This contract will be open for acceptance for a period of thirty (30) days, unless adjusted by PDG or the County in writing.

EXHIBIT A

1. **OWNER'S RESPONSIBILITIES**

OWNER shall provide all criteria and full information as to OWNER's requirements for the project and shall give prompt written notice to PLANNER whenever OWNER observes or otherwise becomes aware of any defect in the work. The OWNER may designate representatives to act with authority on OWNER's behalf on various aspects of the projects.

2. **REIMBURSABLE EXPENSES**

Reimbursable Expenses are included in the compensation fee for basic and additional services and are the actual expenses incurred by PLANNER or PLANNER's independent professional associates or consultants, directly or indirectly, in connection with the Project. These include expenses for: transportation; toll telephone calls; reproduction of reports; pictures, and similar Project-related items.

3. **TERMINATION**

The obligation to provide further services under this Agreement may be terminated by either party (upon seven day's written notice) in the event of substantial failure by the other party to perform in accordance with the terms hereof, through no fault of the terminating party. In the event of any termination, PLANNER will be paid in full for all services rendered to the date of termination, all Reimbursable Expenses and termination expenses.

4. **SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS**

OWNER and PLANNER each is hereby bound as are the partners, successors, executors, administrators and legal representatives of OWNER and PLANNER in respect to any covenants, agreements and obligations of this Agreement. Nothing contained in this Agreement shall prevent PLANNER from employing such independent professional associates and consultants as PLANNER may deem appropriate to help in the performance of services hereunder.

5. **LIMITATION OF LIABILITY CLAUSE**

The PLANNER's liability to the OWNER for any cause or combination of causes is, in the aggregate, limited to an amount no greater than the total compensation earned under this Agreement.

IN THE MATTER OF PROCEEDING WITH THE REICHELDERFER #1 JOINT COUNTY DITCH PROJECT MAINTENANCE HEARING:

Commissioner Begg moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in accordance with O.R.C. §6133.04, the Joint Board may do all things that a board of county commissioners may do in connection with the improvement; and,

WHEREAS, the Auglaize County Drainage Technician TJ Place stated in 1968, the Reichelderfer #1 Ditch open channel was petitioned through Auglaize Soil and Water Conversation District, reconstructed and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Highway Department. This 1.27 mile long improvement drains a watershed of 755 acres and in 1968, cost assessments to the landowners were \$7,080.88 for the reconstruction of the open ditch. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 50 plus years of our department maintaining this project and using the 1968 construction cost as the base amount, this amount is no longer sufficient enough to keep the account stable due to inflation.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and re-evaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After re-evaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$50,052.00. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 1.27 miles of the Reichelderfer Ditch as done in 1968 for \$7,080.80. The watershed boundary was adjusted using modern more accurate topographical data. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 50 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance shortly on this open ditch such as herbicide spraying, periodic bottom dip-outs and erosion control.

- 5) The Clerk of the Board is hereby instructed to give notice by first class mail to every public and private property owner whose property is subject to assessment at the tax mailing or other known address of the owner in accordance with the Ohio Revised Code §6131.07.
