**IN THE MATTER OF SETTING A DATE AND TIME AT WHICH TO CONVENE A PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE GRANT AMENDMENT FOR THE PY2021 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) VILLAGE OF BUCKLAND NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION GRANT (NRG) PROGRAM.**

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The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 22nd day of March, 2022.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, the County of Auglaize, proposes to amend its PY2021 CDBG Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Village of Buckland Neighborhood Revitalization Grant (NRG) agreement with the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) for the funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Community Development Program, a federal program administered by the State of Ohio; and,

**WHEREAS**, the following activities are being proposed to be amended:

**Existing NRG Activities/Budgets/Outcomes: \$725,000**

- 5-1 Flood & Drainage (Main St). LMI National Objective. CDBG Grant: \$257,300.
- 5-2 Installation of 2600LF curb/gutter and 16 catch basins Parking Facilities. LMI National Objective. CDBG Grant: \$96,700.
- 5-3 Resurface 43,000SF of parking (100 spaces/4 ADA spaces) Parks & Rec Facilities. LMI National Objective. CDBG Grant: \$241,900.
- 5-4 Construction of 1 Basketball Court and 1 Restroom (South Park area) Sidewalk Improvements (Main St). LMI National Objective. CDBG Grant: \$129,100.

Installation of 9880SF sidewalk and 10 ADA curb ramps

Due to various factors, including construction inflation, material cost increases/shortages, and current market, Auglaize County on behalf of the Village of Buckland proposes to amend the NRG as follows:

- 5-3 Resurface 40,500SF of parking (78 spaces/4 ADA spaces) Parks & Rec Facilities. LMI National Objective. Amended CDBG Grant: \$46,600.
- 5-4 Construction at South Park area canceled. Proposed construction of 1 Basketball Court at Community Park area
- 5-4 Sidewalk Improvements (Main St). LMI National Objective. Amended CDBG Grant: \$209,400.

Installation of 3,300LF of sidewalk and 11 ADA curb ramps

All terms in the original CDBG Grant Agreement between ODOD and Auglaize County shall remain and no terms of the original agreement, except those set out above, will be changed by the proposed amendment; and,

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio requires Counties to conduct a public hearing to inform all County citizens concerning the grant amendment for the CDBG program in Ohio.
