WHEREAS, on October 31, 2024, the Auglaize County Engineer Andrew Baumer sent written correspondence to the Joint Board of Auglaize and Shelby County Commissioners, to review the plans for the East Shelby Joint Ditch; and,

WHEREAS, Auglaize County Engineer’s Office presented the following correspondence to the Board:

East Shelby Ditch

In 2016, the East Shelby Ditch underwent improvements as a group project and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Highway Department. This 6,851 feet of open ditch that drains a watershed of 1,347 acres in 2016. The lower portion of this ditch (3,175 feet) is located west of East Shelby Road and the upper portion (3,676 feet) is East of East Shelby Road. We have received a request to split these into two separate accounts so the landowners on the bottom end do not have to pay for maintenance performed on the upper portion. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 9 years of maintaining the project with the 2016 base amounts, our department has reassessed the outside watershed boundary, updated parcel land use, and adjusted the total base cost to reflect current market prices. These updates have affected both the total project cost and the individual base costs for the parcels within the watershed.

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and reevaluating of the benefits to the owners within these watersheds and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices of \$96,771.28 for 3,175 feet of open ditch. Upon review of the East Shelby Joint Ditch. This review also includes updating the watershed boundaries as well as modifying the base cost for each parcel for this watershed.

This department has prepared an assessment base for the property owners within the watershed and we are asking the Joint Board of Commissioners to set a date, time and location for the purpose of holding a re-evaluation hearing as outlined in Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code. This department will prepare and mail the notices to the property owners within the watershed.

Commissioner Bambauer moved the adoption of the following:

WHEREAS, in accordance with O.R.C. §6133.04, the Joint Board may do all things that a board of county commissioners may do in connection with the improvement; and,

WHEREAS, the Auglaize County Drainage Engineer Sam Philipot stated in 2016, the East Shelby underwent improvements as a group project and has since been maintained by the Auglaize County Highway Department. This 6,851 feet of open ditch improvement drains a watershed of 1,347 acres and in 2016, cost assessments to the landowners were \$51,338.00 for the reconstruction of the open ditch. Since the original construction, the owners within this watershed were systematically, through base assessments, charged a small percentage of their original assessment to keep this project at 100% of its design capacity. After 9 years of maintaining the project with the 2016 base amounts, our department has reestablished the outside watershed boundaries for both portions of the ditch, updated parcel land use, and adjusted

Section 6137 of the Ohio Revised Code allows for us to review such projects and re-evaluate the benefits to the owners within this watershed and to reestablish the total cost of the project to revised current prices. After re-evaluating the watershed, the new construction base cost for the project is \$27,126.63. This number represents what it would cost today to reconstruct the 3,676 feet of the East Shelby #2 Ditch as done in 2016 for \$7,408.00. The watershed boundary was adjusted using modern more accurate topographical data. The re-evaluation also has taken into account the many new parcel splits and residences built in the watershed over the past 9 years. This base will be used to generate future collections to reimburse the maintenance account to perform maintenance shortly on this open ditch such as herbicide spraying, periodic bottom dip-outs and erosion control.
