

**RE: Cost Estimate for Hydrogeologic Consulting Services –  
2018 Groundwater Monitoring  
St. Marys Landfill**

Dear County Commissioners:

In response to your request for proposal, Eagon & Associates, Inc. is pleased to provide the Auglaize County Commissioners a with a proposed scope of work and cost estimate for providing professional hydrogeologic consulting services relative to groundwater monitoring activities for 2018 at the St. Marys Landfill.

#### **PROPOSED SCOPE OF SERVICES**

Eagon & Associates, Inc. proposes the following scope of services.

##### Task 1. Semiannual Detection and Assessment Groundwater Monitoring

Eagon & Associates will conduct two semiannual groundwater sampling events, one in the spring of 2018 and one in the fall of 2018. The spring 2018 sampling event will include the annual leachate sample for the site. Also included in this task are costs for two resampling events. Eagon & Associates, Inc. will conduct the groundwater sampling events. During the first event we will be familiarizing ourselves with the site and performing a well inspection. We will make well repairs, as necessary, which can be completed with available equipment and materials. If there are more significant well integrity issues that are observed, such as cement pads that need replaced or casing integrity issues, this will be discussed with the Auglaize County Commissioners. This task includes coordinating with the laboratory, sample collection, and documentation. We propose to use Geochemical Testing, Inc. (GTI) as the analytical laboratory. GTI has extensive experience in groundwater sample analysis and reporting requirements for solid waste facilities. GTI will provide bottles, shipment, and perform laboratory analytical services. We have provided a cost estimate from Geochemical Testing, Inc. (GTI) for comparison to costs from your current analytical laboratory (STL – North Canton). If it is requested to include the laboratory costs with Eagon’s cost estimate, then a 10-percent markup will be applied to the laboratory costs.

**Hydrogeologic Consulting**

The cost associated with this task assumes that there are 26 monitoring wells, including investigative piezometers RW-1 and RW-2, located at the site. It is our understanding that these wells are not equipped with dedicated pumps, and have previously been sampled with a peristaltic pump following low-flow procedures. The wells will be sampled as part of the detection and assessment monitoring programs and will be sampled for the same parameters that were analyzed for during both semiannual sampling events in 2017. Based on our review of the 2017 semiannual reports, we have developed a sampling analysis schedule shown on Table 1. We propose to sample the facility wells using the same methods and sample analysis as used in 2017. It is assumed that it will take three days for two people to perform the sampling event.

Eagon & Associates, Inc. will develop a sampling schedule for the contract period and provide a reminder notification to the Auglaize County Commissioners approximately two weeks before the sampling event. We will also coordinate with the analytical laboratory regarding the number and types of analyses to be conducted, including sample bottle shipping and labeling requirements. We will collect site-wide groundwater level measurements in all monitoring wells prior to conducting any groundwater sampling, inspect the monitoring wells during each sampling event, and collect groundwater samples and the appropriate number of QA/QC samples according to the methods outlined in the current sampling and analysis plan. We will complete all relevant documentation including field notes, sample collection records, and chain of custody, and deliver samples to the laboratory via overnight courier.

Task 2. Semiannual Groundwater Monitoring Reports

Eagon & Associates, Inc. will prepare a report documenting the sampling event pursuant to OAC 3745-27-10 after completion of each semiannual sampling event. The report will be provided to the Auglaize County Commissioners for review at least one week before the due date. The analytical data will be checked for completeness and evaluated for data anomalies and discrepancies prior to submittal. The semiannual data will be analyzed using Sanitas, a statistical software program. It will cost \$400 to transfer the license for Sanitas to Eagon from previous consultant. The report will contain data summary tables, field documentation, water-level data, potentiometric maps, chain-of-custody forms, and the complete laboratory data package. Once finalized, the report will be submitted to Ohio EPA within 75 days of the sampling event. This task includes time to prepare two straight-forward alternate source demonstrations.

**ESTIMATED COSTS**

The estimated cost for hydrogeologic consulting services to complete the above work scope is \$29,258.00 as itemized below for each task. Note that the laboratory costs are separate from the estimated costs shown below and will be billed directly by the laboratory.

Note that the analytical laboratory costs are not included in this proposal. GTI's cost for analytical testing for the two semiannual groundwater events, typical resampling, and leachate analysis is \$23,036.80.

A breakdown of our costs to perform the work as described herein is provided on the attached spreadsheet. Billings will be in accordance with the attached fee schedule. We will not exceed the total cost without a mutually agreeable change in work scope and your authorization. Acceptance of this proposal will constitute a contract to execute the work scope as defined herein and provide a corresponding basis for payment. You may indicate your acceptance of this proposal and provide us with formal authorization to proceed by returning one signed copy of the attached Exhibit A to our office.

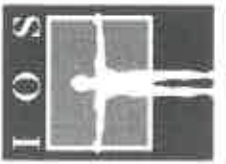

THIS AGREEMENT entered into the 1st day of January 2018 by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF AUGLAIZE, OHIO, hereinafter referred to as "Auglaize County" and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO, hereinafter referred to as "Lucas County".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Auglaize County Coroner has requested that the Lucas County Coroner perform certain necessary autopsies: and

WHEREAS, the Lucas County Coroner has advised that he is willing to perform such services as requested by the Auglaize County Coroner, for the costs incurred during the performance of said work:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed that:  
"Lucas County" will:

- A. Perform complete autopsies and/or limited autopsies as requested by "Auglaize County" all in accordance with the applicable law governing such work.
- B. Complete autopsies will include full body examination, microscopies, and toxicology for drugs of abuse and ETOH.
- C. Provide testimony in cases as required by a court of law.  
"Auglaize County" will:
  1. Provide compensation to "Lucas County" in the amount of \$1,450.00 for each complete autopsy performed, including routine toxicology. Non-routine tests and procedures will be billed separately and according to costs incurred.
  2. Reimburse "Lucas County" for any travel necessary to provide testimony as required by law, at the current IRS standard mileage business rate.
  3. Be responsible for transporting the body to and from the Lucas County facility. Universal precautions are to be used in transport. Should a body not be in a body bag when received at LCCO, the Auglaize County Coroner's office will be charged \$25.00 for a regular body bag and \$65.00 for an extra large body bag.

It is further agreed by all parties herein concerned that this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for a period of twelve (12) months effective January 1, 2018 and terminating December 31, 2018. It being understood, however, that either party may terminate this Agreement by giving thirty (30) days written notice of their intent to terminate such Agreement.


