**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has been allocated the sum of \$198,000 under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG Allocation Program, providing program requirements are met; and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board has reviewed all requests received for funding and has proposed the following projects be submitted as the county's Allocation grant application:

**NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING**  
**PY2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)**  
**Allocation Grant and Neighborhood Revitalization Grants**

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners intends to apply to the Ohio Development Services Agency (ODSA) for funding under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Community Development Program, a federal program administered by the State of Ohio. The first of two required public hearings was held March 29, 2021 to inform citizens about the CDBG program, eligible activities, and other requirements. The Board publicly solicited project proposals from villages, cities, townships, and other eligible entities in the County. Proposed use of funds is set forth below.

Community Development Allocation Grant: Auglaize County is eligible to utilize \$198,000 of CDBG Allocation funds providing program requirements are met. Based on citizen input and local officials' assessment of needs, compliance with a CDBG National Objective, inclusion in County's Community Development Implementation Strategy (CDIS), number of beneficiaries served, and number of previous awards, the Board is proposing to use Allocation funds as follows:

Village of Waynesfield Neighborhood Revitalization Grant (NRG): The County is eligible to utilize up to \$750,000 of CDBG Community Development NRG funds providing program requirements are met. Auglaize County, on behalf of the Village of Waynesfield, plans to apply and is proposing to use NRG funds as follows in the Village of Waynesfield: Street Improvements; Flood & Drainage Facilities; Water Facility Improvements; Sidewalk Improvements; Public Utilities; and Solid Waste Disposal Facility. Project Activities: up to \$700,000 and General Administration: up to \$50,000. Total NRG: up to \$750,000.

Village of Buckland Neighborhood Revitalization Grant (NRG): The County is eligible to utilize up to \$750,000 of CDBG Community Development NRG funds providing program requirements are met. Auglaize County, on behalf of the Village of Buckland, plans to apply and is proposing to use NRG funds as follows in the Village of Buckland: Sidewalk Improvements; Park Improvements; Flood & Drainage Facilities; and Parking Facilities. Project Activities: up to \$700,000 and General Administration: up to \$50,000. Total NRG: up to \$750,000.

A second public hearing will be convened by the Board on Monday, May 24, 2021 at 10 a.m. in the Commissioners Chambers located in the Administration Building, 209 South Blackhoof Street, Room 201, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895 to give citizens an opportunity to review and comment on the County's proposed projects before the grant applications are submitted to ODSA on or before June 16, 2021.

Citizens are encouraged to attend this public hearing to express their views concerning the applications.
