**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has reviewed an agreement with Wapakoneta Health Facilities LLC for costs incurred in backfilling a demolition site so that the property is suitable for future construction and for re-routing the sewer line on Parcel No. B0720100102; and,

**WHEREAS**, Auglaize County shall be responsible for contracting, overseeing, and completing the following work, all in compliance with federal, State of Ohio, and local laws, regulations, and permitting requirements:

- a) Backfilling of excavated areas with suitable fill material
- b) Compaction and stabilization of the backfilled areas to render the site reasonably suitable for future construction
- c) Re-routing of sewer line; and,

**WHEREAS**, Wapakoneta Health Facilities LLC agrees to reimburse the County for the actual and reasonable costs incurred in connection with the work, not to exceed \$204,000.00, remitting payment within 60 days of receipt of invoice.
