NOTICE OF SECOND PUBLIC HEARING

PY2022 COMMUNITY HOUSING IMPACT & PRESERVATION (CHIP) PROGRAM

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) for funding of Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) Program activities under the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Small Cities Program and the Federal HOME Investment Partnership Program (HOME), both federally funded programs administered by the State of Ohio. The CHIP Applications are due to the State by June 22, 2022.

On February 28, 2022, Auglaize County conducted the first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program, how it may be used, what activities are eligible, and other program requirements.

Based on a County housing needs assessment, Auglaize County is proposing to undertake the following County-wide PY2022 CHIP activities: Private Owner Rehabilitation \$580,000 (HOME); Owner Home/Building Repair \$300,000 (CDBG); Fair Housing \$7,500 (CDBG); and General Administration \$120,000 (\$54,500 CDBG and \$58,000 HOME). CHIP activities satisfy the LMI National Objective. The County is applying for a total of \$1,000,000 to fund these activities. Housing Program Income is also being committed to CHIP activities.

A second public hearing will be convened by the Board on Monday, May 16, 2022, at 10:00 a.m., in the Commissioners Chambers located in the Administration Building, 209 South Blackhoof Street, Room 201, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895 to give citizens an opportunity to provide input on the activities.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 3rd day of April, 2022.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2020, in Resolution #20-384, the Board of County Commissioners executed an administrative contract with Poggemeyer Design Group for services for the County's PY2020 Community Housing Impact and Preservation (CHIP) Grant at the compensation amount of \$101,000.00; and,

WHEREAS, the contract amendment No. 1 was approved in Resolution #21-426 dated on October 14, 2021 by \$3,000; and,

WHEREAS, this contract amendment increases the contract line item for Home Repair Project Soft Costs. Original contract included eight (8) Home Repair units. This contract amendment increases the total number of Home Repair projects/units to ten (10), which increases Project Soft Costs; and includes the following additional one (1) project/unit: Phase 635-118 South Wentz Street, Wapakoneta, OH (\$3,000). Total increase for Home Repair Project Soft Costs included in this contract amendment is \$3,000 which increases contract line item for Home Repair from \$27,000 to \$30,000 (to be paid from CHIP Grant Funds). ADDITIONALLY, PDG would appreciate consideration to re-coup additional charges incurred for inspection services due to client/contractor issues for completion of (635) of \$821.00 (total PDG charges incurred for this project was \$4,861.35). The additional \$821 would allow PDG to offset charges incurred and would be paid from home repair grant funds remaining (Total soft costs charged for Phase 635 - \$3,821); and,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners has agreed to this increase; and,

WHEREAS, an Administrative contract amendment No. 2 has been prepared by Poggemeyer Design Group reflecting above mentioned fee increase; same is to be executed by the President of the Board.
