IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE AUGLAIZE COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS TO CERTIFY THE FINAL NOTICE AND PUBLIC EXPLANATION OF A PROPOSED ACTIVITY IN A 100-YEAR/500-YEAR FLOODPLAIN AND THE NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST RELEASE OF FUNDS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT PY2025 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) FLEXIBLE GRANT PROGRAM.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County met in regular session on the 5th day of May, 2026.

Commissioner Bambauer made the motion to adopt the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners has received a PY2025 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Flexible Grant Program for the St. Marys Theater & Grand Opera House is located at 115-123~~122~~121st Spring Street in Auglaize County, Ohio. General project activity scope is an exterior façade/code improvement and private rehabilitation activity located in the City of St. Marys. Source of Federal Funds: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Flexible Grant and City of St. Marys Economic Development Revolving Loan Fund (EDRLF). Location: City of St. Marys, Auglaize County. General project activity scope is façade code improvements/private rehabilitation. Specifically, the façade/code improvement and private rehabilitation project will consist of Fire Escape Replacement; removal and disposal of four (4) existing fire escapes; furnish and install three (3) new fire escapes. New fire escapes to be galvanized steel and painted black; tuckpoint and repair brick as needed at removal locations; brickwork repair areas to be painted black to match rest of the building; new mortar must match existing in texture, compressive strength, and tooling. Additionally, the project will include Screen Wall: furnish and install 12' high x approximately 10' long metal siding clad screen wall in front of the existing electrical meters; metals to match the existing on other areas of the building; and a gate is to be included to allow access to the electrical meters. The proposed project activity involves approximately 0.4 acres of floodplain and is not anticipated to negatively impact floodplains. General Administration is also a component of the project; and,

WHEREAS, Auglaize County has considered the following alternatives and mitigation measures to be taken to minimize adverse impacts and to restore and preserve natural and beneficial values: No Action; Develop a Different Site and Development of This Site.

- “No Action” alternative fails to address existing needs to address façade/code improvements and private rehabilitation activity at the project site, located at 115-123 West Spring Street.
- “Develop a Different Site” alternative fails to address the façade/code improvements and private rehabilitation investment needed to improve the project site, located at 115-123 West Spring Street, which happens to be located in the floodplain.
- “Development of This Site” is the only practicable alternative. The project should not negatively affect the floodplain since the project activities (façade/code improvement and private rehabilitation) involve an existing structure on a previously developed site.
- Auglaize County Board of Commissioners acknowledges compliance with state and local floodplain protection procedures; and,

WHEREAS, the Environmental Review Record (ERR) has been completed for the projects listed above; and,

WHEREAS, the required public notice of the above final notice/public explanation and the notice of intent to request release of funds sets forth a period of time expiring on May 14, 2026 at 4:30 p.m. during which time written comments regarding both the final notice and notice of intent to request release of funds will be received by the Commissioners' Office for consideration.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio hereby authorizes and directs the Clerk of the Board to post the herein described Public Notices and formally authorizes the publication of the same in The Evening Leader and The Wapakoneta Daily News on May 7, 2026; and,
