

IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING FRANK'S CONTRACTING AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES TO REMOVE SNOW FROM PARKING AREAS AT THE AUGLAIZE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF JOB AND FAMILY SERVICES.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 14th day of November, 2023.

Commissioner Bambauer moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is necessary to contract snow removal services for the Auglaize County Department of Job & Family Services; and,

WHEREAS, a proposal from Frank's Contracting and Maintenance Services has been submitted to the Board of County Commissioners for snow removal services for the parking areas at the department; and,

WHEREAS, said agreement would be in effect from November 1, 2023 through June 1, 2024 at a fixed unit rate of \$375.00 per each occurrence for 2 – 6 inches of snow or \$525.00 per each occurrence for 6-12 inches of snow. Skid loader if needed is \$180.00/hour. Salt will be \$.50 a lb. spread with \$30.00 trip charge for each salt event. All invoices must be submitted within 30 days of the service being performed and this contract may not exceed \$7,000.00 unless otherwise amended; and,

WHEREAS, the Board has been requested to approve the agreement and authorize Frank's Contracting and Maintenance Services to perform snow removal services at the Auglaize County Department of Job & Family Services as specified above.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio does hereby approve the agreement of Frank's Contracting and Maintenance Services and does authorize said company to perform snow removal services at the Auglaize County Department of Job & Family Services as so proposed; and,

IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH LUCAS COUNTY CORONER FOR AUTOPSY SERVICES; RATIFYING THE EXECUTION OF SAID CONTRACT.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 14th day of November, 2023.

Commissioner David Bambauer moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, a contract was presented to the Board of County Commissioners by County Coroner Jason Stienecker from the Lucas County Coroner for autopsy services as requested and needed by Coroner Jason Stienecker; and,

WHEREAS, said contract would be effective January 1, 2024 and terminates December 31, 2024 with the fees of \$1,750.00 per autopsy (which includes routine toxicology). Auglaize County would also be responsible for travel reimbursement at the current IRS standard mileage business rate, and be responsible for transporting the body to and from the Lucas County facility. Universal precautions are to be used in transport. Should a body not be in a body bag when received at LCCO, the Auglaize County Coroner's office will be charged \$25.00 for a regular body bag and \$65.00 for an extra-large body bag; and,

WHEREAS, Coroner Stienecker approved the terms of the contract and requested that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, authorize and execute the contract.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners does hereby authorize the contract as presented by the Lucas County Coroner for autopsy services as requested by the Auglaize County Coroner; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio does hereby ratify the execution of said contract.

AGREEMENT

In the matter of autopsies performed] Auglaize County Commissioner's

THIS AGREEMENT entered into the 1st day of January 2024 by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF AUGLAIZE, OHIO, hereinafter referred to as "Auglaize County" and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO, hereinafter referred to as "Lucas County".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Auglaize County Coroner has requested that the Lucas County Coroner perform certain necessary autopsies: and

WHEREAS, the Lucas County Coroner has advised that he is willing to perform such services as requested by the Auglaize County Coroner, for the costs incurred during the performance of said work:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed that:
"Lucas County" will:

- A. Perform complete autopsies and/or limited autopsies as requested by "Auglaize County" all in accordance with the applicable law governing such work.
- B. Complete autopsies will include full body examination, microscopies, and toxicology for drugs of abuse and ETOH.
- C. Provide testimony in cases as required by a court of law.
"Auglaize County" will:
 1. Provide compensation to "Lucas County" in the amount of \$1,750.00 for each complete autopsy performed, including routine toxicology. Non-routine tests and procedures will be billed separately and according to costs incurred.
 2. Reimburse "Lucas County" for any travel necessary to provide testimony as required by law, at the current IRS standard mileage business rate.
 3. Be responsible for transporting the body to and from the Lucas County facility. Universal precautions are to be used in transport. Should a body not be in a body bag when received at LCCO, the Auglaize County Coroner's office will be charged \$25.00 for a regular body bag and \$65.00 for an extra-large body bag.

IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING THE PETITION AND BOND FOR THE ROEDIGER #3 SINGLE COUNTY DITCH PROJECT; FIXING DATE OF VIEW AND HEARING FOR SAME.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 14th day of November, 2023.

Commissioner David Bambauer moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on November 9, 2023 the Drainage Technician TJ Place filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, a petition signed by Lynn Gerstner and others as petitioners, to locate, install subsurface tile and catch basins, attach and install laterals to existing lines, install fittings and elbows, and place catch basins or manholes as required to satisfy the prayer of the petition. If and when the project has been completed, the landowners shall have the drainage improvements placed on permanent County Maintenance as per Section 6131 and 6133 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Said petition being located in Section 24 of Moulton Township, Auglaize County, Ohio;

Commencing at an existing catch basin located on the North side of Infirmary Road approximately 2,600 feet east of Buckland River Road and Infirmary Road intersection, in the Northwest Quarter of Section 24 of Moulton Township in Auglaize County, Ohio; Thence continuing in a Northwest direction across the Michael Springer (G22-241-003-03), Michael Barnes (G22-241-004-00) and Richard Koenigh (G22-241-004-02) properties to a point approximately 270 feet due North of Infirmary Road and approximately 1,670 feet east of the Infirmary Road and Buckland River Road intersection; Thence continuing in a Southwest direction across the Koenig property to a point at the North right of way of Infirmary Road and approximately 1,160 feet east of the Buckland River Road and Infirmary Road intersection and there to terminate. The above subsurface tile being located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Moulton Township and Northeast Quarter of Section 24 in Auglaize County, Ohio;

Said improvement is to be known as the Roediger #3 Single County Ditch.

The above described construction; all cost of engineering, construction and future maintenance shall be assessed to the benefitting parcels of ground as described in Section 6131 of the Ohio Revised Code. Exact sizes, depth and location will be depth and location will be determined at the time of the engineering study between the first and second hearings; and,

WHEREAS, it appears to said Board that the proper bond has been filed with the petition, approved, conditioned for the payment of costs of notices, plus any other incidental expenses, except the cost made by the Engineer in making his survey, maps, plans, profiles and schedules, if the prayer of the petition is not granted, or if said petition is for any cause dismissed.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby accept the petition and bond for the Roediger #3 Single Ditch Project; setting the **4th day of January, 2024, at 1:30 p.m., local time**, meeting in the Assembly Room-2nd Floor, Administration building, Wapakoneta, Ohio as the time and place for the view thereon; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the **1st day of February, 2024 at 1:30 p.m. local time**, in the Assembly Room - 2nd Floor, Administration Building, Wapakoneta, Ohio, be and the same is hereby fixed as the time and place for the first hearing on the petition; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that notice of said view and hearing to be given as requested by law.

In the Matter of the ROEDIGER #3 Single County Ditch;

LOCATE, INSTALL SUBSURFACE TILE and CATCH BASINS, ATTACH and INSTALL LATERALS.

Proceedings to: To investigate the feasibility to replace an existing subsurface tile, install catch basins, make connections, and install sub-mains if required. If and when the project has been completed, the landowners shall have the drainage improvements placed on Permanent County Maintenance as per Section 6131 and 6133 of the Ohio Revised Code.

Petitioned for by: **LYNN GERSTNER** and others,

The undersigned hereby makes application to your honorable body for: To locate the existing tile, replace and install new subsurface tile and catch basins, make lateral connections, install fittings and elbows, removal and disposal of brush, and place erosion control as needed in order to satisfy the prayer of the Petition.

The construction of the improvement is necessary, and will be conducive to the public welfare. The following is the course and termini of said improvement, to wit:

Commencing at an existing catch basin located on the North side of Infirmary Road approximately 2,600 feet east of Buckland River Road and Infirmary Road intersection, in the Northwest Quarter of Section 24 of Moulton Township in Auglaize County Ohio; Thence continuing in a Northwest direction across the Michael Springer (G22-241-003-03), Michael Barnes (G22-241-004-00) and Richard Koenig (G22-241-004-02) properties to a point approximately 270 feet due North of Infirmary Road and approximately 1,760 feet east of the Infirmary Road and Buckland River Road intersection; Thence continuing in a Southwest direction across the Koenig property to a point at the North right of way of Infirmary Road and approximately 1,160 feet east of the Buckland River Road and Infirmary Road intersection and there to terminate. The above subsurface tile being located in the Northwest Quarter of Section 24, Moulton Township and Northeast Quarter of Section 24 in Auglaize County, Ohio.


