The Board of Auglaize County Commissioners met in regular session on the 21st day of November, 2023.

Commissioner Bambauer moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on October 31, 2023, the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners approved the petition and bond and set the dates for the view and First Hearing on the Spray #3 Ditch, located in Section 5 in Salem Township petitioned by Betty Schamp and others; and,

WHEREAS, after said approval, on November 16, 2023, landowner Thomas Menchofer filed an application for change or extension of the improvement was filed; same being:

To make an application to the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County to extend the investigation of the tile being currently under county petition of the Spray #3 Tile Ditch for subsurface drainage improvements, and to place under permanent maintenance, the current petition is currently filed by Betty Schamp;

Said application for an amendment to the current Spray #3 Ditch petition is as follows:

Amendment: Commencing at the end of petition 12” subsurface tile Spray #3 Ditch; at a point approximately 1400 feet west of State Route 116 and in the Southeast Quarter of Section 5, Salem Township of Auglaize County;

Thence in a southeasterly direction, following the general course of the existing subsurface tile, for approximately 1420 feet through the property of Thomas Menchofer (J28-051-004-00) and here to terminate approximately 900 feet west of State Route 116 Road and 20 feet north of Salem-Noble Road. The above described 12” diameter subsurface tile being located in the Southeast Quarter of Section 5 in Salem Township, Auglaize County, Ohio.

The exact size(s) of dimensions and location(s) of said ditch construction shall be determined by the Auglaize County Engineer at the time of the Survey and Design of the proposed drainage petition.

All costs of engineering, construction, and future maintenance shall be assessed to the benefiting parcels of land as described in Section 6131 of the Ohio Revised Code.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners does hereby approve the request for said change or extension of the Spray #3 Ditch as per the signed application from Thomas Menchofer and that said extension be part of the plan for construction.
