**IN THE MATTER OF APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH LUCAS COUNTY CORONER FOR AUTOPSY SERVICES; RATIFYING THE EXECUTION OF SAID CONTRACT.**

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The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 3rd day of October, 2019.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, a contract was presented to the Board of County Commissioners by County Coroner Thomas Freytag from the Lucas County Coroner for autopsy services as requested and needed by Coroner Thomas Freytag; and,

**WHEREAS**, said contract would be effective January 1, 2020 and terminates December 31, 2020 with the fees of \$1,450.00 per autopsy (which includes routine toxicology). Auglaize County would also be responsible for travel reimbursement at the current IRS standard mileage business rate, and be responsible for transporting the body to and from the Lucas County facility. Universal precautions are to be used in transport. Should a body not be in a body bag when received at LCCO, the Auglaize County Coroner's office will be charged \$25.00 for a regular body bag and \$65.00 for an extra-large body bag; and,

**WHEREAS**, Coroner Freytag approved the terms of the contract and requested that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, authorize and execute the contract.

**THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Auglaize County Commissioners does hereby authorize the contract as presented by the Lucas County Coroner for autopsy services as requested by the Auglaize County Coroner; and,

AGREEMENT

In the matter of autopsies performed       ]     Auglaize County Commissioner's

THIS AGREEMENT entered into the 1st day of January 2020 by and between the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF AUGLAIZE, OHIO, hereinafter referred to as "Auglaize County" and the BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF LUCAS COUNTY, OHIO, hereinafter referred to as "Lucas County".

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the Auglaize County Coroner has requested that the Lucas County Coroner perform certain necessary autopsies: and

WHEREAS, the Lucas County Coroner has advised that he is willing to perform such services as requested by the Auglaize County Coroner, for the costs incurred during the performance of said work:

NOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed that:  
"Lucas County" will:

- A. Perform complete autopsies and/or limited autopsies as requested by "Auglaize County" all in accordance with the applicable law governing such work.
- B. Complete autopsies will include full body examination, microscopies, and toxicology for drugs of abuse and ETOH.
- C. Provide testimony in cases as required by a court of law.  
"Auglaize County" will:
  - 1. Provide compensation to "Lucas County" in the amount of \$1,450.00 for each complete autopsy performed, including routine toxicology. Non-routine tests and procedures will be billed separately and according to costs incurred.
  - 2. Reimburse "Lucas County" for any travel necessary to provide testimony as required by law, at the current IRS standard mileage business rate.
  - 3. Be responsible for transporting the body to and from the Lucas County facility. Universal precautions are to be used in transport. Should a body not be in a body bag when received at LCCO, the Auglaize County Coroner's office will be charged \$25.00 for a regular body bag and \$65.00 for an extra-large body bag.

It is further agreed by all parties herein concerned that this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for a period of twelve (12) months effective January 1, 2020 and terminating December 31, 2020. It being understood, however, that either party may terminate this Agreement by giving thirty (30) days written notice of their intent to terminate such Agreement.

**IN THE MATTER OF AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER #2 AND CHANGE ORDER #3 TO THE CONTRACT WITH SHINN BROS., INC. FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE AIRPORT DRAINAGE AND UTILITY REHAB PROJECT; AUTHORIZING THE PRESIDENT OF THE BOARD TO EXECUTE SAID CHANGE ORDERS.**

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The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 3rd day of October, 2019.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

**RESOLUTION**

**WHEREAS**, on December 28, 2017, in Resolution #17-539, the Board of County Commissioners executed a contract with Shinn Bros., Inc. for the Neil Armstrong Airport Drainage and Utility Rehab Project. Shinn Bros., Inc. has stated in the contract that the base amount for the above mentions project is \$748,085.50 plus change order #1 of \$40,603.35 for a new contract total of \$788,688.85; and,

**WHEREAS**, a change order #2 has been presented to furnish and install all necessary labor and material for the following items:

- 1) Per ODOT requirements, Sanitary MN S2 near SR 219 pavement edge needed additional grading so MH did not protrude above finished grade; add \$5,807.50; and,
- 2) Added time of six days with this change order #2; and,

**WHEREAS**, a change order #3 has been presented to delete the parking lot and apron from the contract price:

- 1) Remove the parking lot and apron from the project; deduct (\$115,922.00); and,

**WHEREAS**, the total contract amount for the changes stated above for Change Orders #2 and #3 is (\$110,114.50); and,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners has agreed to these changes; and,

**WHEREAS**, a Change Orders #2 and #3 have been prepared by Shinn Bros. reflecting above mentioned fee changes; same is to be executed by the President of the Board.

**THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby approve the Change Orders #2 and #3 for the contract with Shinn Bros. Inc. for professional services for the airport drainage and utility rehab project; and,

## SERVICE AGREEMENT


November 1, 2019

Party of the first part agrees to provide an Avitrol treatment program for pigeon control on the Auglaize County Courthouse. The party of the first part agrees to provide all labor and materials necessary when the time is optimum for the treatment to be made. The party of the first part will assume the primary responsibility of bird pick-up and disposal. Party of the second part will assist in the daily responsibility of bird pick-up.

In consideration of this agreement, the party of the second part agrees to pay the party of the first part the sum of \$500. Payment to be made within 30 days of invoicing.

Party of the first part carries Workers' Compensation Insurance and Public Liability/Property Damage Insurance to the \$5,000,000 limit.


