IN THE MATTER OF ACCEPTING THE PETITION AND BOND FOR THE MIAMI ERIE CANAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT; FIXING DATE OF VIEW AND HEARING FOR SAME.

The Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio met in regular session on the 6th day of October, 2009.

Commissioner Regula moved the adoption of the following

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, on October 1, 2009, the County Design Engineer Matt Quinter filed with the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, a petition signed by Dennis Kitzmiller and Donald W. Harrod, Mayor and Village Administrator, respectively, of the Village Minster; on behalf of the Village of Minster as petitioners, to locate, remove obstructions (brush, trash, etc.), provide a deepened outlet for subsurface drainage, install erosion control structures and stabilize banks on the following described course;

Commencing at a point located on the north side of the bridge across the Miami and Erie Canal on First Street in the Village of Minster. From this point, follow along the existing Miami and Erie Canal in a northerly direction thru the Village of Minster approximately 1.0 miles to the intersection of the Miami & Erie Canal and Seventh Street. Thence along the existing Miami and Erie Canal approximately 0.5 miles to the intersection of the Miami and Erie Canal and State Route 119 and there to terminate.

The above described construction, engineering, and maintenance shall all be assessed to the benefitting parcels of ground as required under Section 6131 of the Ohio Revised Code.

The exact method of construction and engineering shall be determined at the time of the engineering study and field survey to be performed by the Auglaize County Engineer's Office between the first and second legal hearings.
