RE: The Continuation of the Established Special County Recorder Technology Fund for the purpose of acquisition and maintenance of imaging and other technological equipment and contract services.

Gentlemen,

In accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 317.321, which became effective on July 1, 2001 and then amended by the 128th General Assembly effective July 18, 2010, the 129th General Assembly effective March 27, 2013, the 130th General Assembly effective September 29, 2013, and the 133rd Ohio General Assembly effective October 17, 2019, and the 135th General Assembly effective October 3, 2023, I am submitting for your consideration my request to continue the special County Recorder Technology Fund for the acquisition and maintenance of imaging and other technological equipment and contract services.

I am respectfully requesting that the already set and established Six Dollars (\$6.00) of the fees collected for filing or recording a document for which a fee is charged be continued and placed in the County Treasury and designated as the "General Fund Money to Supplement the Equipment Needs of the County Recorder" (aka- "Recorder Fund") under division (A)(1)(2)(3) of the ORC 317.321 for the period of Five years(5) under division (B)(2) of the same ORC section.

The continued fee collection is proposed as follows:

- 1). Pursuant to Ohio Revised Code, the Recorder states that beginning January 1, 2025, and ending December 31, 2029, an amount equal to Six Dollars (\$6.00) of the fee collected for filing or recording a document for which a fee is charged as required by ORC sections 317.32(A), 1309.525 and 5310.15 be placed in the County Treasury and designated as "General Fund Moneys to Supplement the Equipment Needs of the County Recorder" (aka-"Recorder Fund").
- 2). The Recorder requests that the moneys so designated bear such designation for a period of five (5) years or until December 31, 2029.

- 3). Based on a 12 month average from September 2025 through August 2026, the Recorder estimates the office will generate an average to the County General fund in the amount of \$13,126.28, per month in total fees from filing and recording documents as scheduled under ORC sections 317.32(A), 1309.525 and 5310.15. These estimates do not include amounts collected for and sent to the State of Ohio for the Housing Trust Fund.
- 4). Based upon a 12 month average from September 2025 through August 2026, the Recorder estimates that a Six Dollar (\$6.00) allocation to the office will generate an average of \$2,690.00, per month in fees designated as "General Fund Moneys to Supplement the Equipment Needs of the County Recorder" (aka-"Recorder Fund") from filing and recording documents as scheduled under ORC sections 317.32(A), 1309.525 and 5310.15.
- 5). The funds will continue to be used for payment of contract services, reservation of funds for the office's future equipment needs and improvements needed to the office technology to maintain the proficient service of the office as it is now.

Pursuant to ORC section 317.321, not sooner than the fifteenth nor later that the thirtieth day after the Board's receipt of the proposal, the Board is required to meet with the Recorder to review the proposal. Such meeting shall be in open public session in accordance with ORC section 121.22.

To that end I humbly ask that you strongly consider continuing the Recorder's Fund for the acquisition and/or maintenance of imaging and other technological equipment and contract services for the five year period provided for in the Ohio Revised Code from January 1, 2025 and ending December 31, 2029. For your convenience I have included a copy of the Ohio Revised Code Section 317.321.
