RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Auglaize County Department of Job & Family Services has chosen to contract with Tri Star Career Compact pursuant to the Personal Responsibility and Work Opportunity Reconciliation Act H.R. 3734, Workforce Investment Act, House Bill 408, and rules promulgated by the Ohio Department of Job and Family Services; ACDJFS is authorized to contract with public and/or private agencies for the purchase of TANF/OWF/PRC, WIOA, Title XIX, and Title XX social services; and,

WHEREAS, a contract for specific social services between the Auglaize County Department of Job and Family Services has been submitted to the Board of County Commissioners with a request that the Board approve and execute same at the terms so stated in said contract for the time period from September 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020 at the cost not to exceed \$11,000.00.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby approve and authorize the contract for TANF/OWF/PRC, WIOA, Title XIX, and Title XX social services between Auglaize County Department of Job and Family Services and Tri Star Career Compact; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board ratifies the execution of said contract.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, under date of January 3, 2019, the Annual Appropriation for Auglaize County was accepted, having been prepared with the 2019 Annual Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Resources which was given to the Board of County Commissioners by the County Auditor; and,

WHEREAS, County Auditor Janet Schuler informed the Board that an amendment was made to the Annual Amended Official Certificate of Estimated Revenue for the County Club Hill Estates Fund (110) by \$2,700.00; and,

WHEREAS, Auglaize County Engineer requested that the Board amend the 2019 Annual Appropriation to reflect the following increase:

- Increase 110.0016.530300 (Supplies) by \$100.00;**
- Increase 110.0016.530500 (Contract Repairs) by \$600.00;**
- Increase 110.0016.530600 (Contract Services) by \$2,000.00.**

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby order the 2019 Annual Appropriation Resolution be amended to show the change as tabulated above.

**IN THE MATTER OF FINDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE SHINDOLLAR DITCH PROJECT;
PETITIONED BY MATTHEW SHINDOLLAR; SETTING DATE TO RECEIVE ENGINEER'S REPORTS ON
SAID PROJECT.**

The Board of Auglaize County Commissioners met in regular session on the 12th of September, 2019.

Commissioner Bergman moved the adoption of the following:

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners, in Resolution #18-535, dated December 27, 2018, set March 12, 2019 at 1:30 p.m., for the first hearing of the petition of the Shindollar Ditch Project, the Board met in the Assembly Room – 2nd Floor at the Administration Building and conducted the hearing by causing the petition to be publicly read to those present by TJ Place for the County Engineer's Office; and,

WHEREAS, the Board finds that due and legal notice was given for the March 12, 2019 hearing and has been given in the manner and for the length of time required by law for the September 12, 2019 hearing, to all owners of land affected by said improvement; and,

WHEREAS, the Board made an actual view of the proposed improvement on February 12, 2019 and has heard either in person or by counsel all evidence offered by any owner of land for or against the granting of the proposed improvement, or for or against the granting of any laterals, branches, spurs, or change of route, course, termini, or manner of construction described in the petition, or any application therefore; and,

WHEREAS, at the March 12, 2019 hearing, the Board gave a six-month extension for the landowners to complete the work for the Shindollar County Ditch Project by September 1, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, on August 29, 2019 in Resolution #19-348 the Board of County Commissioners set the date, time and place to reconvene the First Hearing for the Shindollar County Ditch Project as September 12, 2019; and,

WHEREAS, during the reconvened hearing it was confirmed that the landowners had not completed the work and the County Engineer's Preliminary Report has determined that the route and termini of the proposed improvement meets the prayer of the petition and that there are no reasonable alternative routes; and,

WHEREAS, the cost of the proposed improvement is less than the benefits derived.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners, Auglaize County, Ohio, does hereby direct the County Engineer to proceed with the necessary survey for the proposed improvement, perform the necessary engineering calculations, develop the necessary plans for the drainage system and structures including profiles showing the cuttings and gradient of the improvement, create maps showing the location of the land proposed to be assessed and make an estimate of the cost of the construction of the improvement. Then Engineer' Report shall include the actual construction cost estimate, the cost of engineering, and the cost of notices, publication and other incidental expenses; and set proper construction stakes, and perform such other duties as required by Section 6131.14 of the Ohio Revised Code; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board does set **September 24, 2019 at 10:30 a.m.** as the date and time for the filing of the above mentioned County Engineer's Reports.
