NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
**PY2022 Community Housing Impact & Preservation
Lead Abatement Program (CHIP-LAP) & Equipment Grant**

The Auglaize County Board of Commissioners intends to apply to the Ohio Department of Development (ODOD) for funding under the Community Housing Impact and Preservation Lead Abatement Program (CHIP-LAP) & Equipment Grant, a collaborative program with the Ohio Department of Health (ODH) administered by the State of Ohio. The CHIP-LAP Applications are due to the State by September 28, 2022.

On February 28, 2022, Auglaize County conducted its first public hearing to inform citizens about the CDBG program, eligible activities, how it may be used, and other program requirements. A second public hearing for the Community Housing Impact & Preservation (CHIP) was conducted May 16, 2022.

CHIP-LAP supplemental funds will be awarded on a competitive basis to current CHIP grantees to allow for purchase of an X-Ray Fluorescence (XRF) Analyzer or re-sourcing of an existing analyzer already owned by the grantee and/or administrator. Supplemental funds are also available for lead hazard control work and related costs for LMI-owned/occupied properties in conjunction with CHIP Rehabilitation and Home Repair activities.

Based on a county assessment of needs, Auglaize County is proposing to apply for and use CHIP-LAP funds County-wide as follows: Machine/Capital Equipment up to \$23,000, for purchase of XRF; and Lead Reduction/Evaluation \$60,000, for lead hazard control work and related costs at CHIP-eligible units in need of rehabilitation or repair. Activities satisfy the LMI National Objective of Benefit to Low-and-Moderate Income (LMI) Households and will be used in conjunction with CHIP funding. The County is applying for a total of \$83,000 to fund these activities.

A third public hearing will be convened by the Board on Monday, September 26, 2022, at 10 a.m. in the Commissioners Chambers located in the Administration Building, 209 South Blackhoof Street, Room 201, Wapakoneta, Ohio 45895 to give citizens an opportunity to review and comment on the County's proposed activities.

Should any participant require auxiliary aids due to disability or non-English languages, please contact this office at least one week prior to the hearing date to ensure needs will be accommodated.
